Dear Mr. Secretary-General,

I am pleased to confirm that APRIL Group supports the ten principles of the Global Compact on human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. With this communication, we reiterate our intent to implement those principles. We are committed to making the Global Compact and its principles part of the strategy, culture and day-to-day operations of our company, and to engaging in collaborative projects which advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals. APRIL Group, through our Sustainable Forest Management Policy, has made a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

We are aware that a key requirement for participation in the Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress (COP) that describes our company's efforts to implement the ten principles. It is unfortunate that due to gaps in our communications team, we have missed a reporting period which has caused us to be delisted as a member as at October this year. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress within one year from our reinstatement in the Global Compact, and annually thereafter according to the Global Compact COP policy.

This includes:

- A statement signed by the chief executive expressing continued support for the Global Compact and renewing our ongoing commitment to the initiative and its principles. This is separate from our initial letter of commitment to join the Global Compact.

- A description of practical actions (i.e., disclosure of any relevant policies, procedures, activities) that the company has taken (or plans to undertake) to implement the Global Compact principles in each of the four issue areas (human rights, labour, environment, anti-corruption).
- A measurement of outcomes (i.e., the degree to which targets/performance indicators were met, or other qualitative or quantitative measurements of results).
