I am pleased to confirm that Geocell LLC supports the ten principles of the Global Compact on human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. With this communication, we would like to highlight our strong commitment to the implemented policies and instructions, which directly correspond and are based on the Global Compact principles. Being part of the international group (TeliaSonera), gives us the advantage of having the good practices of all the sustainable processes and polices in place, such as: Code of Ethics and Conduct, Privacy Policy, Freedom of Expression in Telecommunications, Anti-Bribery and Corruption, etc. These processes are the core of the strategy, culture and day-to-day operations of our company. Therefore, we are committed to engaging more in collaborative projects which advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals. Geocell LLC will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

Due to some circumstances in the past years we had missed deadlines of submitting COP. Consequently, Geocell was excluded from the list of the member companies of Global Compact. We will appreciate your kind decision to re-include our company in the Global Compact Network, as we are committed to sharing our COP within the set deadlines and fulfilling the responsibilities taken upon us.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress (COP) that describes our company's efforts to implement the ten principles and support any specialized UN Global Compact issue platform that our company may join at a later date. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress within one year of joining the Global Compact, and annually thereafter according to the Global Compact COP policy. This includes:

- A statement signed by the chief executive expressing continued support for the Global Compact and renewing our ongoing commitment to the initiative and its principles. This is *separate* from our initial letter of commitment to join the Global Compact.
- A description of practical actions (i.e., disclosure of any relevant policies, procedures, activities) that the company has taken (or plans to undertake) to implement the Global Compact principles in each of the four issue areas (human rights, labour, environment, anti-corruption).
- A measurement of outcomes (i.e., the degree to which targets/performance indicators were met, or other qualitative or quantitative measurements of results).
