For the year 2015 we failed to renew the membership due to change of personnel. We regretted the mistake and hereby would like to resubmit the LOC and resume our participation in The Global Compact. We are of course willing to pay for the outstanding years fee together with the 2016 fee.

I am pleased to confirm that Trayton Group supports the ten principles of the Global Compact on human rights, labor, environment and anti-corruption. With this communication, we express our intent to implement those principles. We are committed to making the Global Compact and its principles part of the strategy, culture and day-to-day operations of our company, and to engaging in collaborative projects which advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals. Trayton Group will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress (COP) that describes our company's efforts to implement the ten principles and support any specialized UN Global Compact issue platform that our company may join at a later date. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress within one year of joining the Global Compact, and annually thereafter according to the Global Compact COP policy which includes a statement signed by the chief executive expressing continued support for the Global Compact and renewing our ongoing commitment to the initiative and its principles, a description of practical actions that the company has taken(or plans to undertake) to implement the Global compact principle, and a measurement of outcomes.
