CMC effectively aided the Nepal population affected by the 2015 earthquake placing its Camp in Sindhupalchowk Region at people and Local Authority's disposal for emergency rescue; the role of CMC as private supporter has been pointed out from the UN Office of the Resident Coordinator.

Anti-corruption

CMC has been granted as Company free of infiltration of the Mafia risk in the White List issued by several Government Territorial Offices according to the Italian Laws directives. CMC is undertaken to select suppliers and subcontractors having the same requirement as well.

CMC is about to gain the Legality Rating granted by the National Antitrust Authority according to the Italian Laws directives. The Legality Rating is granted subject to the fulfillment of condition related to economic, Mafia, financial and fiscal crimes no-commission.

CMC gained a third part certification of its own Ethics and Anti-corruption System in compliance with the Italian Law Decree 231/2001; the certification has an annual validity subject to an extension audit.
