The conference was based on the Millennium Development Golas and UN Global Compact Initiative and subsequent G Global Initiative of President Nursultan Nazarbayev of Kazakhstan.

- c. Harare Conference in Zimbabwe ( 3 June 2014) in cooperation with European Council on Tourism ad Trade and Zimbabwe Minister of Tourism

- d. Bucharest Conference on World Democratic Models presenting the importance of democracy and liberty as fundamentals in promoting development, equilibrium and in insuring the Millennium Development Goals and UN Global Compact targets.
