Banque Libano-Française Interim Report on UNGC COP Report

Banque Libano-Française (BLF) is a participant of the Global Compact since October 17, 2014 and an active member of the Global Compact Local Network Steering Committee in Lebanon since May 2015.

We hereby reaffirm our continuous support to the 10 principles in the areas of Human Rights, Labor, Environment and Anti-Corruption.

Before joining UNGC, BLF was selected by LIBNOR (The Lebanese Standards Institution, attached to the Lebanese Ministry of Industry) amongst several applicants to participate, as a pilot organization, in the uptake and use of ISO 26,000 to further integrate Social Responsibility in its behaviors, business operations and interactions with stakeholders.

Following a conduction of a gap analysis based on ISO 26,000 7 principles, BLF modified in 2014 its Mission Statement to reflect shared value and sustainability, and formulated a new CSR strategy and action plan.

We are aware that a key requirement of being a UNGC signatory is the publishing of an annual Communication On Progress Report. However due to our new strategy, kindly note that we will need to align our COP deadline with the publishing date of our first CSR report which will cover the years 2014-2015.

In this report, planned for October 17, 2016, we will share information concerning our SR strategy, a statement of continuous support for the UNGC from our General Manager, a description of actions in the 4 areas of Human Rights, Labor, Environment and Anti-Corruption, explanations about how we follow ISO 26,000 principles in our four pillars: Marketplace, Workplace, Community and Environment, as well as a measurement of outcomes.
