PROFOH has continued to work in partnership with several Global Compact members, and UN agencies such as UNODC, Stop TB Partnership etc these partnerships has been instrumental in developing and delivering key program and projects that raise awareness on the fight against corruption and provided quality health care for vulnerable populations and advance their rights on access to health care. In particular, this partnership and collaboration with others contributed to the to the performance of thousands of free surgeries in several countries and over a million clinical consultations and treatments and is supporting the process of quality public health.

PROFOH has developed a new partnership with some corporate bodies like Keystone Bank for Sierra Leone for that country comprehensive health intervention Corporate Social Responsibility program and Appod Nigeria for a similar program in Nigeria and Ghana, these firms share the same commitment to social justice, their support was also very vital in our interventions in Nepal during the massive earthquake that struck that country in April and May 2015 in line with Principle 1.

PROFOH partnership with United Nations Convention against Corruption coalition(UNCAC) another Global Compact member, led to the appointment of its Executive Director as the regional coordinator for West and Central Africa(25 countries) in July 2012,

Measurement of outcomes (i.e. qualitative or quantitative measurements of results)

- PROFOH has been recognized as organization as a leading humanitarian organization and won the prestigious Award in 2013 by Global Thinkers Forum under the auspices of City of Athens, Greece. We have received official invitations from several countries including Cameroon, South Sudan, etc
- PROFOH Executive Director was appointed the regional coordinator for West and Central Africa (25 countries) in July 2012, an assignment that increased membership and expanded the war against corruption, with a new definition added to corruption dictionary, (stealing of election result became corruption for the first time in the region and thus reforms were introduced by some governments) it made a difference.
