COMMUNICATION OF ENGAGEMENT TO UN GLOBAL COMPACT

In the context of our membership of the UN Global Compact, our organization has continued to take into account its principles in all our policies and actions. We have been particularly active in the following two areas in recent months:

- *Labor:* we continued to hold regular meetings with the leading Catalan labor unions and have intensively worked together in the drafting of the Catalan Cross-sector Framework Agreement on Work Conditions (AIC). This Agreement sets forth the basic rules for all collective bargaining agreements in Catalonia and shall come into force before the end of 2015. The AIC agreement covers a wide array of areas, from accident prevention to wage setting and employee mobility.
- *Anti-corruption:* with rampant corruption in Spain at all levels of the political scene, our organization has been very active in fighting against this miserable practice. We have held a number of meetings with the new Anti-Corruption Committee of the Catalan Parliament and have also worked together on the drafting of the new Transparency Law, which came into force in December 2014.

PIMEC shall continue to adhere to the principles of UN Global Compact and incorporate them into their daily activities and future plans.
