Web Indexing Seminar in Accra, Ghana: AFRICT attended an interactive seminar on web indexing in Accra, Ghana organized by the World Wide Web Foundation with CODESRIA and others in attendance. Statistical data put Nigeria's ICT penetration at about 23.5% with a global ranking of 48 on the web index.

The summit put youth engagement at the centre of the ICT development agenda for Africa and took place alongside a one day forum showcasing the proactive steps that Mauritius is taking to encourage the growth and sustainability of its own ICT industry. The event was organized to share best practices and overcome the challenges which are currently inhibiting youth engagement in ICT in order to empower youth and make Africa an ecologically sustainable environment in the future.
