Similarly, it is being processed by many developing countries. Conversion of wastes to clean energy was also elaborated. Re-enchanting the World with the Post-2015 Development Agenda - A collaboration between NGOs and UNESCO

The 2014 International Conference of Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs) is being held from 15 to 17 December 2014 at UNESCO Headquarters in Paris with focus on the theme "Re-enchanting the World with the Post-2015 Development Agenda". Vice President Robert Holtz will be present as WUSME Representative. The Union's request to obtain Consultative Status with UNESCO is underway. First step of the procedure, to formally deposit the documentation required, has been successfully accomplished. The Conference is to provide a welcome opportunity to examine collective NGO action carried out in 2013 and 2014, and will adopt the main lines of collective cooperation for 2015-2016. It is organized around four subthemes: "The Involvement of NGOs for the Promotion of Quality Education in the Post-2015 Agenda"; "Water and Sustainable Development: From Awareness-Raising to Decision-Making"; "Enhancing Cultural Heritage and Fostering the Diversity of Cultural

Expression"; and "Climate Change: Acting Now". Quality Education, Sustainable Development and Climate Change are issues WUSME is concerned about and involved in, as as witnessed by the events, programs and projects. The International Conference of NGOs brings together all of UNESCO's NGOs in official partnership with UNESCO every two years. It is a key forum in which UNESCO's official NGO partners meet and hold discussions, its primary purpose being to "review the state of cooperation with UNESCO [...] and facilitate cooperation between organizations having common interests".

Ban Ki Moon and the General Director of UNIDO, H.E. Li Jong. The UNIDO's Programme for Country Partnership highlights the importance of cooperation with the

He also emphasized the importance of international financial institutions. UNIDO had some 300 experts working on diverse aspects of inclusive and sustainable industrial development and over 1,000 project personnel spread all over the world. This visit has resulted into a gaining momentum and a better understanding of UNIDO's partnership-based approach in order to define concrete working models of cooperation between Governments, UNIDO and stakeholders for promoting ISID investment in line with post 2015 SDG. Outputs of the initiative have been to showcase UNIDO's ISID Programme for Country Partnerships, through two pilot countries, to private and public stakeholders and initiate a partnership dialog in selected beneficiary countries; define the collaboration modalities of innovative business models to forge partnerships in order to scale up ISID investment and impact in assisted member countries; agree on the way forward for the sustainable development of UNIDO Partnerships for ISID investment in 2015 and beyond. In addition, side meetings have been held to discuss cooperation with UNIDO in the following fields of activities, such as training, renewable energy, organic farming, gender issue.



WUSME 'S SUBMISSION OF WRITTEN STATEMENT FOR THE 59TH SESSION OF THE UN COMMISSION ON THE STATUS OF WOMEN OCTOBER 24, 2014

As NGO in consultative status with the Economic and Social Council, WUSME had the opportunity to successfully submit a written statement for the fifty-ninth session of the Commission on the Status of Women (CSW59) on 24 October 2014 via CSO-Net. The document has been co-authored by Dr Pauline T Crawford, WUSME Representative, Gender Dynamics® Expert and International Speaker, along with guidance from WUSME Board and Headquarters. Don't miss to read it! Written statements are to be relevant to the work of the Commission on the thematic issues of the session. The main focus of the session will be on the Beijing Declaration and Platform for Action, including current challenges that affect its implementation and the achievement of gender equality and the empowerment of women. The Commission will undertake a review of progress made in the implementation of the Beijing Declaration and Platform for Action, 20 years after its adoption at the Fourth World Conference on Women in 1995. The review (Beijing+20) will also include the outcomes of the 23rd special session of the General Assembly, the first five-year assessment conducted after the adoption of the Platform for Action, which highlighted further actions and initiatives. The session will also address opportunities for achieving gender equality and the empowerment of women in the post-2015 development agenda.



WUSME VISIT TO UNOV, THE OFFICE OF THE UNITED NATIONS IN VIENNA SEPTEMBER 30 - OCTOBER 1, 2014

WUSME Delegates to UNOV and UN-ECOSOC Susanne Forstinger, Alexander Forstinger and Norbert W. Knoll von Dornhoff visited the Office of United Nations in Vienna on September 30 and October 1 to meet with officials of the Office of Nations United, UNIDO and UNODC - United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime. The meetings led to positive results in view of a collaboration of WUSME with the UNIDO Global Forum (particularly with the Business, Investment and Technology Services Branch), the UNCITRAL - United Nations Commission for international-trade law- working on international agreements to facilitate trade between SMEs and UNODC under the program launched to facilitate the sale of products of alternative development of small enterprises on national and international markets. WUSME Representatives are working to propose projects based on alternative agriculture.



MASTER CRAFTSMEN OF SAN MARINO AS TEACHER FOR THE REFUGEES OF DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO

WUSME, the Secretariat of State for Labour of the Republic of San Marino and UNAS (National Craftsmen Union of San Marino) signed an agreement for the promotion and realization of international programs of training in entrepreneurship and crafts, to be held in the Professional Training Centre of San Marino with the cooperation of Master Craftsmen members of UNAS, in order to train groups of students coming from different parts of the world, especially from emerging and less privileged countries, such as the Democratic Republic of Congo, where WUSME has conceived the creation of an entrepreneurial and professional training program in favor of 26,500 refugees for which is now awaiting th eapproval and contribution of the UNHCR (United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees) in Geneva.

MEETING BETWEEN WUSME PRESIDENT TERENZI AND PRESIDENT OF CHINA XI JINPING MAY 15, 2014
