#### ASSIGNMENT & AREA REPORT

1. Visited Office of the Commissioner of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region 10 Feb 2015. Together with there were around 100 members joined this event.
  - We gave introduction of mission and Vision of JCI and JCIHK to Deputy Commissioner of the Office
  - Director-General of the office Ms. Cui Ying have hosted a seminar for us, International Current Affairs.
2. Have arranged workshop in UNESCO HK Peacemakers' Cultural Celebration
  - The topic is how to be an active citizen
  - 30 youths and have joined our program
3. Promote 2015 JCI Global Partnership Summit
  - 5 members registered join the program
  - After JCI Global Partnership Summit, those 5 members have hosted a seminar to teach more about summit to members of JCIHK
4. Nothing but Coffee
  - This event is a fund raising program to raise fund for Nothing but Net Foundation of United Nations to Combat Malaria in Africa to Echo one of UNMDGs
  - Invited our affiliated Chapter to organize the event this year
  - Coffee Café Company – Pacific Coffee have sponsor us for 2000pcs Coffee voucher, and we sell it at \$100 each one, and all money from the selling will be donated to nothing but net foundation
  - Opening Ceremony was held on 9 May 2015, We invited Dr. Angela Cheung (Vice President of UNESCO HK) as the GOH
  - Up to report date, over 1300pcs of Coffee vouchers and have successfully raised over HK\$130,000.

5. CSR day
  - The program consisted of two parts:
  - Part 1 : CSR survey announcement – We invited The Honorable Mr. K S Wong, Secretary for Environment, HKSAR government as our GOH
  - We have successfully engaged 13 news coverage.
  - Part 2 : Eco forum – We invited Executive Vice President of Junior Chamber International Ms. Natalie Viselli as GOH
  - We invited 3 speakers to share on the result of CSR survey include Prof. Patrick Lau, SBS, JP, UNESCO Hong Kong Association, President Mr Henry Ngai, CEO of Hong Kong Organic Waste Recycling Centre Limited and Mr. Mike Milburn, Senior Manager of Environment of HK Airport Authority
  
6. We Unite for a Better World Campaign
  - We target to promote UNMDGs to Public included Commercial Sector, NGOs and schools, it also divided in two parts
  - Part 1: We have invited World Green Organization as our Strategic partner and assisted us to access private section. They helped us to recruit over 80 commercial companies to support UNMDGs included Several Multi National Group
  - The first Logo Presentation day have successfully held on 22 July 2015 over 100 Company representatives have joined the ceremony
  - Part 2: We target for recruiting NGOs and schools and to recognize their achievements in contributing UNMDGs
  - Over 30 parties have joined the campaign.
  - The Logo Presentation day have held on 12 September 2015
  
7. Assist 20 Affiliated Chapter to renew or apply UN Global Compact
  - In 2012 and 2013, JCI Hong Kong and 19 LOMs have engaged with UN Global Compact, and support aspect of their mission.
  - They need to submit “COE” to continue keep the engagement with UN Global Compact before 31st Oct 2015. Email set out the details of renewal procedures to NOM and LOMs was sent out; include the information on how to engage with UN Global Compact.
