

## **Renewal of our Commitment to the United Nations Global Compact**

I am pleased to inform that Isolux Corsan Group has renewed its commitment to the **Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact** and to present our fourth Report since we signed up in 2010 to the sustainable development strategy promoted by the United Nations.

With a clear global commitment, in 2014 the Group increased its presence abroad and 87% of the EPC portfolio now comes from overseas. This fact continues to define and guide our corporate responsibility actions, which are sensitive to the particular features and culture of each country in which we operate.

This global commitment results in the creation of local employment and educational actions and helps to enhance the quality of life of the local population. The year 2014 saw social education and training projects in Armenia, Brazil, Colombia and India, collaborations in various campaigns with Hospitals and schools in Mexico and Argentina and continuation of the disability integration projects commenced in Spain in 2011.

One of the main actions relating to responsibility and transparency, which culminated in 2015, was the launch and implementation of the code of ethics and anti-corruption protocols applicable to all the Group's employees and collaborators, creating follow-up and control mechanisms through the Supervisory Body.

Transmitting the Organization's commitments to sustainability and its culture remains one of the main pillars of the Group's Corporate Responsibility. We have therefore continued with our work on implementing the Quality, Environment and Health and Safety Systems in the countries in which we operate, involving our providers and collaborating with local communities

Within the area of R&D&I I would like to highlight the successful completion of five projects, two relating to our commitment to health and safety and a further three which obtained significant results with regards to seeking more efficient water purification and regeneration mechanisms in advance of future European guidelines.

In 2015 the company will continue to work on consolidating the mechanisms of ethical and anti-corruption performance, transmitting these requirements to our interested parties. Aware of the fact that the Group's entire success and expansion is thanks to the effort of each and every one of the people who make up the Group, we will continue with our commitment to training programmes and policies, talent retention, equality, international mobility and prevention of occupational accidents.
