UNGC 2015 COMMUNICATION OF PROGRESS – THE DELIAN PROJECT


Dear Ms Jorgensen,

As an inaugurating signatory to UN Global Compact (UNGC) Canada, the DELIAN Project Board of Directors recognizes a requirement for its participation within the UNGC is the annual preparation and posting of a Communication on Progress (COP) that comprises of a CEO statement of continued support for the UN Global Compact, a description of practical actions with regard to the principles of the UN Global Compact, and a measurement of outcomes or expected outcomes.

2015 was a break through year for DELIAN, both in terms of its efforts abroad and its adherence to the UNGC principles.
