

DESCRIPTION OF ACTIONS

(1) Have a dedicated sustainability plan or a holistic city/regional plan that incorporates the ecological, economic, political, and cultural dimensions of the region's sustainability;

The Valletta Local Council between 2013-2015 continued to implement its HERO Action Plan which responds directly to actions that support the UNGCCP principles. The sustainable conservation plan for this UNESCO World Heritage City a system called CHIMP. The project considered a number of flagship projects to spur the economic development of 4 main neighbourhoods in the Marsamxett area. The projects include; the re-adaptive re-use of St. Augustine's Convent, the rehabilitation of Mattia Preti Square, CULTS Peacock Gardens redevelopment, Il-Biccerija rehabilitation and regeneration project.

(2) Engage at the Innovating Level – undertaking a multi-year project to address a complex or seemingly intractable issue(s) within the city or region, which is supported by leaders across business, civil society and Government.

All the projects Valletta Local Council developed through its HERO Action Plan have had an element of innovation and research including; ERDF: CULTS Cultural Urban Landscape for Tourism Sustainability which project saw the redevelopment of a garden and the installation of WHS Information booth indicating the heritage resources and promoting business in the area. The innovative developments in the other projects i.e. St. Augustine's Convent, the rehabilitation of Mattia Preti Square include the inclusion of ITC to promote social inclusion and a community based museum.

(3) Implement and promote the ten principles of the UN Global Compact in the management and administration of the city or region;

The projects delivered by Valletta Local Council in the past two years which includes the Sustainable Urban Mobility Plan and the rehabilitation of public spaces sought to develop further the 10 principles through; democratisation in planning, transparency and new governance opportunities.
