KaushalyaGramodyogSansthan Is a non-government organization that works empowering the most vulnerable and deprived sections of the society. Towards the social, research,economics and political empowerment of women remains a key priority area for the organization. The organization also strives for maintaining a balance between the technological advancement and indigenous cultural values of human kind. It strongly encourages advancement and indigenous cultural values of human kind. It strongly advocates for equity to the accessibility and use of natural resource in a sustainable manner. The development strategy of the organization has always been based on people's needs,their cultural values, indigenous knowledge and traditional skills. The organization subscribe to the process approach rather than the service delivery approach and therefore the focus of its

interventions is on building the capacity of the communities rather than providing them direct developmental support. The welfare approach being pursued by the Government of India for the past 50 years has failed to improve the socio –economic status of the marginalized and deprived section of the society and the organization is instead focusing on a rights-based approach to development.

The last four year experiences in working with the rural communities have strongly reinforced the belief that development is a continuous process, which cannot be achieved in a short span of time. Development shown positive trends of growth which the community themselves feels, need and realizes the important maintaining it in a sustainable manner. Based upon our understanding all the development interventions need to focus on search for alternative options, addressing different type problems at the community level, then building their capacity and later developing a sense of ownership among them.

Based upon the diverse socio –cultural and different geo political characteristics of the state, we have identified strengthening of local self-governance institutions and the sustainable management of natural resources as key thematic areas.

HIV/AIDS, Cancer and other kind of prevention and treatment of dreaded diseases in cooperation and collaboration with official and non-official agencies for providing total health coverage.

Undertake all types of projects taken by Central and State Social Welfare Boards to help handicapped, aged persons, destitute, widows and other vulnerable section of population for their rehabilitations.

2. PROGRESS ACHIEVED BY KAUSHALYA GRAMODYOG SANSTHANIN 2014-15

The Kaushalya Gramodyog Sansthan Achievements has been stated in the following paragraphs as under

❖ **Voice of the voice Less**

The Kaushalya Gramodyog Sansthan actively advocates for the rights of the most deprived and vulnerable sections of the society and simultaneously build the capacities of the communities so that they speak for themselves.

❖ **Public Service Contractors**

We work as service provider in the field of health, educations and vocational programme and do our job on our own support rather expecting support from any government agencies or private service providers.

❖ **Collaborator**

We act as a collaborator of the government and the private corporate sectors in activities where community participation is necessary.

❖ **Social Innovator**

We experiment with new technology, new service and new methodologies for social upliftment.

❖ **Social innovator**

We are social critic and policy advocate for some specific issues like child labour, trafficking ,environment problem ,violence against women etc.

Kaushalya Gramodyog Sansthan is relentlessly making effort to improve the socio economic status for the rural communities by carrying out various projects particularly on entrepreneurship development, capacity building education, health and natural resource management under all its programmes.The organization gives almost priority to womens,SC,ST and other socially and economically disadvantage group.More over community mobilization in the form of women self -help group, youth group also remains a major thrust area.

2. ENTREPRENEURSHIP DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

Kaushalya Gramodyog Sansthan has realized that economic deprivation is one of the major issues facing the rural communities in Uttarakhand. The lack of alternate livelihood opportunities in the remote hill village is the most important reason to this scenario. Therefore skill building is alternate source of livelihood also termed as entrepreneurship development programme has been one of the core activities of the organization during the past few years.

The programme interventions are being carried out in the Roorkee town and Haridwar district. This programme is focus on rural women in the age group of 18-45 years largely drawn from the marginalized and backward sections of the society. The objective of the programme is to train the women in certain vocational skills that would enable them to earn their livelihood.

The organization has its own training center where the selection is done through oral test. This is done so that a needy person is selected who cannot afford the training expenses on their own. In this regard the organization has already imparted specific skill in various alternate craft like tailoring and embroidery, knitting and weaving patch work, typing and computer literacy to nearly 1000 women. A large number of these trainees have started to take up such activities at the village level and earning between Rs. 500 to 1000 per month.

Now the organization is exploring the possibilities of linking these trainees with the market in the city of Roorkee. It is in the process of talking with various garments shop, tailoring shop etc. Roorkee for procuring order from them which would increase the market demand for the products being made by the rural women and thus further augment their incomes.

3. NON – FORMAL EDUCATIONS

Kaushalya Gramodyog Sansthan strongly believes that education is the stepping-stone for all community development activities. We have been engaged in conducting children as well as adult education programmes, which are briefly discussed below.

Children education has been a key priority area for us. However we do not believe in creating parallel structures i.e we feel that since government schools are in place in most of the areas therefore there is no point in setting up more formal schools. Thus according to us the real need is to encourage the parents to send their children to school (particularly the girls) and also to prevent school dropout. It has been our experience that while the enrolment has improved steadily in the Haridwar district, the dropout ratio (particularly of the children belonging to the marginalized sections) remains substantially high.

In order to minimize the incidence of dropout ratio Kaushalya Gramodyog Sansthan is running non-formal education centers in the Roorkee and Bhagwanpur block of Haridwar district. The aim of these centers is to eventually bring back children in age-group of 6-14 in to the formal system of education, approximately 20 students have been enrolled in each center and thus a total of approximately 15 children are studying in these centers. Girls constitute nearly 75% of enrolled students as the majority of dropout cases comprises of girls. The organization has adopted 01 orphan child from the vulnerable sections of the society and is bearing all the expenses of their education like providing school fees, dress, booklet. The organization has not received any funds for it and they are voluntarily taking responsibility of these children.

4. ADULT EDUCATIONS

The organization is also engaged in non-formal education for adults, particularly for the women. It has initiated an adult education programme in the villages in the Roorkee and Haridwar district where SHG members have been imparted literacy skills. In fact, a total of 10 SHGs have benefited from these programmes most of whom were in the age group of 15 to 45 years. It has been observed that education has brought significant changes in the confidence and awareness levels of the women. Moreover the social status (both inside and outside the household) has also been significantly enhanced. Subsequent to the education programme these people have been imparted training on accounting and book keeping which helped them to maintain the records of their SHGs.

However, until now we have deliberately refrained from taking any funding for children or adults education programmes and have instead used our own resources (through the various projects/programmes) for the purpose.

5. COMMUNITY HEALTH PROGRAMMES

Health is an imported index of human development. The status of health depends on health awareness of the community, the availability of Preventive and Curative health and medical health services, besides access to adequate nutrition and safe drinking water. The non-availability of required medicines and inadequate care in the primary health centers are complaints against the primary health care system. The health status of the poor people in general and that of women and children in particular is very low. The incidence of TB, respiratory infections, high infant mortality rate and other waterborne diseases are common. We organized some health camp on reproductive child health general health, Malaria detection camp, TB detection camp, dental care etc. Health meals and blood donation camps were also organized by the organization. We are also creating awareness among the women regarding the pre and post pregnancy care, breast feeding practices, safe drinking practices, diarrhea control, advantage and disadvantage regarding the family planning methods and clearing out the misconceptions regarding the family planning methods in order to increase the usage of these methods. Sanitation drives were also held by school going children in order to keep the surrounding neat and clean in this regard. Kaushalya Gramodyog Sansthan has also taken initiative and constructed one toilet in the villages in the Haridwar districts.

6. INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT

The organization has achieved quite a significant progress with regard to infrastructure development with respect to setting up of its own water testing laboratory and constructing its own office building. The office building have a good ventilated Director chamber accompanying with its Office Secretary chamber. A big training hall equipped with all training facility for conducting various other training programmes, another hall used to imparting training on ‘ tailoring and cutting’ a

separate computer room consisting of good number of computer, reception counter and a well equipped water testing M/C . It has four rooms in which trainees could be accommodates for training programme. Further, it is planning to construct its own hostel with a capacity of accommodating participants of various works at a time along with food facility to them.

7. TRAINING

8. GENDER EQUITY

Although the 73 constitutional amendment provides the facility to involve women in the decision making process at the grass root level by giving 33 per cent reservation in the assembly seats, though their political career does not seem very satisfactory. Most of the elected women in Panchayati Raj functionaries are merely proxy representatives of their male counterparts. Thus the vision of women focused development through women PRFs still remains a distance dream.

But due to exceptional efforts made in this direction by the organization have promoted women leadership in the Panchayat Raj Institutions. We are working in Haridwar and Roorkee block of Haridwar district in order to promote informed participation of women in all the three tiers of the Panchayati raj system in this direction we have divided our programme in to three distinct phases namely in pre election ,during the election and post election period.

During pre election phase, training is being imported to all the village women and the objective of these training are to make them aware about the operational procedure of the panchayats the need for women's involvement in the panchayats .the imported of casting the franchise. Especially the ignorant women are made aware about the right method of casting their votes.

On election phase basically focuses on activities just prior to the elections on the prospective women candidates contesting election. This phase takes about a month time .in this phase the prospective women candidates are motivated and taught about special skill like campaigning process ,how to speak before public ?they are also assisted in filling their nominations and if required talks are with the male member of their families so that they do not object them from contesting elections. Also women from SC/ST category helped to get their caste certificates ect.

The focus during past election phase prepares them to carry out their responsibility more effectively. They are told about the operational features of panchayati raj system and imported training in micro planning method and how to identify issues that need to be focused on for the development of the village .confidence building is another imported component. Many avtimes,they need to be taught of minute things like, how to sign on revenue stamps, how to sign cheques and how to withdraw /deposit money.

9. VOCATIONAL TRAINING:

15 young women youth were provided training in computer education. They have been given a diploma certificate in computer education with objective to get job elsewhere in the country. The organization is running a two wheeler repairing center at Development Block-Roorkee, District Haridwar. During the reporting year 15 youth have been provided training in repairing of two wheeler with objectives to initiate their self employment.

10. WOMEN AND CHILDREN HEALTH AWARENESS CAMP:

Kaushalya Gramodyog Sansthan maintained continuity of health awareness camp an conducted 2 camps on health, hygiene, balance diet, safe drinking water, protecting from frequent sickness and seasonal diseases.

11. ENVIRONMENT AWARENESS PROGRAMME

Organized 2 environment awareness camps in Haridwar. Educated 20 men and women about community environment, community environment, family environment and protection of the area from environmental hazards by not creating different kind of solution such as excessive use of pesticides, cutting and falling of trees, water pollution etc.

12. FAMILY PLANNING AWARENESS CAMP:

A 1 day Family Planning and Family Welfare Education Programme was organized in Kaushalya Gramodyog Sansthan in which 28 women individual participated including the Volunteer in Haridwar and women from 18 village of block Bhagwanpur. Dr. Tyagi gave information to women on the diet that they should take during pregnancy period. Similarly she spoke on exclusive breast feeding till the age of 4 to 6 months. Made aware to 25 couples about need and importance of small family of 1-2 children. Family counseling has also been initiated in the project area, eligible couples are taken into confidence and then advise to plan their family according to their wishes so that there is a small family.

13. AIDS & CANCER CONTROL PROGRAMME:

Acknowledging the need of prevention of HIV and AIDS, we have initiated educational programme for the men and women. In the rural areas problem is aggravating on account of the fact the most of the earning young men are migrant worker in the cities and industrial areas. Sex is a weak point in the life so there are chances of transmission of HIV/AIDS by the husband to the innocent wife who are 90% illiterate. Also made aware about the drastic disease like cancer and how to prevent from it.

14. DRUG DE-ADDICTION AWARENESS PROGRAMME:

The problem is aggravating because of organization impact. The local community is habituated of taking alcohol in the evening. Normally men starts drinking from sun

set upto 2-3 hours before sleeping. It is quite normal to find out many persons fully drunk in the day time. There are some women who also drink. We have organized 3 camps and made aware them the bad effects and impact of the same on life and health.

15. HANDICAP CONTROL

During the month of June 2009, the Kaushalya Gramodyog Sansthan collected information on the major cases of handicap and planned plan action along with a local doctor Dr. Arun. The Kaushalya Gramodyog Sansthan collected also names of volunteers who could involve in the training in. All 12 youth from 08 villages were invited to training programme on prevention and control of an incident. The training also took up First Aid tip for early attention to an injured. The training of two days was organized on 28 and 29 February-2015. The social and psychological aspects were undertaken by the president and Secretary and members of Kaushalya Gramodyog Sansthan.

16. CONSUMER WELFARE PROGRAMME:

Two camps were organized for 48 men and 47 women on their right to protect from exploitation from the business houses, business communities, and service providers under Consumer Protection Act of Government of India. They were educated and trained about the methods, manners and legal provisions protecting themselves. They were also trained in the procedures of protecting their interest by filling their legal cases in the District Consumer Forums.

17. KHADI KARIGAR JANASHREE BIMA YOJANA”

1. Introduction

A Group Insurance Scheme for khadi workers, namely, “KhadiKarigarJanashreeBimaYojana” was launched during X Five Year Plan through KVIC on 15th August 2003 By the Government of India (in the erstwhile

Ministry of Small Scale Industries and Agro & Rural Industries), with LIC of India as insurers. The Scheme covers spinners, weavers, pre-spinning artisans and post-weaving artisans engaged in the khadi sector. This scheme, like other Group Insurance Schemes, does not have any terminal benefit for the beneficiaries as this is not a Life Insurance Scheme. The scheme provides only risk cover for death/disability and the worker is not entitled to get any returns on the premium paid by him or paid on his behalf by KVIC/khadi institutions, if he survives the entire period of insurance.

2. Benefits under the scheme

This scheme initially provided each artisan with risk cover of upto (i) Rs. 20,000 for natural death and Rs. 50,000 for death due to accident, (ii) Rs. 50,000 for permanent disability (loss of two eyes/limbs of use) due to accident, and (iii) Rs. 25,000 for partial disability upto 2005-06 while w.e.f. 2006-07 the LIC of India has enhanced risk cover for the khadi artisans and the revised risk cover provided to each artisan is (i) Rs. 30,000 for natural death and Rs. 75,000 for death due to accident, (ii) Rs. 75,000 for permanent disability (loss of two eyes/limbs of use) due to accident, and (iii) Rs. 37,500 for partial disability, without charging any additional cost either to the beneficiary or to the Government of India.

The Shiksha Sahayog Yojana is add-on coverage under JBY, without any additional premium. The wards of the khadi artisans (benefit restricted to two children per member/family) covered under the JBY are entitled to receive upto Rs. 1200 per annum per ward towards tuition fee under the Shiksha Sahayog Yojana. This benefit is only for wards studying in classes IX to XII, including those studying in Industrial Training Institutes (ITI).

7. SCHEME MANAGEMENT

- The scheme is first of its kind in the country covering such a big number of artisans in the unorganized sector and has been successful.
- Though initially there were certain problems to mobilize the artisans in considerable number from all over India and also with regard to preferring the claims by a number of Khadi institutions, the progress achieved has been commendable.
- With the experience gained by the LIC of India and KVIC, both the agencies simplified the operational modalities. The field offices of KVIC now need to deal with one designated unit of LIC for taking service of the scheme. The State/Divisional Directors of KVIC have been authorized to countersign and to furnish the list to such of LIC designated offices and whenever claims arise they are being settled on the basis of this list.
- Both KVIC and LIC nominated the Nodal Officers at their respective Central Offices to attend to queries, problems etc. faced by field offices of

KVIC, LIC and Khadi institutions. They are free to contact these nodal officers directly.

- Periodical review of the scheme is taking place amongst Director (Khadi Coordination) and Executive Director of LIC as to the settlement of claims etc.
- A Joint Communiqué has been issued simplifying the procedure adopted by the field offices of KVIC and LIC for quick settlement of issues.

18. SHIKSH SAHAYOG YOJANA :

This is a scholarship scheme launched on 31.12.2001 for the benefit of children of members of JanashreeBimaYojana.

ELIGIBILITY :

Students studying in 9th to 12th standards (including ITI), whose parents are covered under JanashreeBimaYojana. If a student fails and is detained in the same standard, he will not be eligible for scholarship for the next year in the same standard.

BENEFITS :

Scholarship of Rs.300/- per quarter per child will be paid for a maximum period of four years.

The benefit is restricted to two children per member (family) only.

PREMIUM :

No premium is charged for the scholarship.

HOW TO CLAIM SCHOLARSHIP :

- i) The member of JanashreeBimaYojana whose child is eligible for scholarship shall fill up an application form (available with Nodal Agency) as per proforma Annexure-I and submit it to the Nodal Agency.

The application form has to be submitted every year for claiming the scholarship

- ii mentioning whether the child is promoted or detained.

- iii) A list of beneficiary students submitted by the institutions should be certified by the officers nominated by KVIC to the concerned LIC P&GS Unit for disbursement of scholarship with full details such as, name of the student, school name, class, members name, master policy no., membership no.

- v) LIC will send the Account Payee cheque in the name of the Nodal Agency along with list of beneficiary students who will pass on the scholarship to eligible students every quarter.
