To our stakeholders,

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual preparation and posting of a Communication on Progress (COP) that comprises of a CEO statement of continued support for the UN Global Compact, a description of practical actions with regard to the principles of the UN Global Compact, and a measurement of outcomes or expected outcomes.

We are late in creating, sharing and posting our COP report due to the aftermaths of Paris' terrorist attacks last November. As security providers, we have been dealing with an unusual amount of requests, comprising lately of the Football EURO League happening in France, and some highly secured events such as the Lions Festival that took place in Cannes last June.

Nevertheless, we managed to realize our first voluntary carbon assessment and report this year, as foreseen in our last COP Active. We plan to submit a report that would prove our involvement in the UN Global Compact and our wish to implement its requirements further, aiming to reach a GC Advanced level of COP.

We hereby ask for an extension period in order to be able to post a COP that describes our company's efforts and progress to implement the principles of the UN Global Compact. Our new COP report will be posted on the UN Global Compact website by October 13th 2016 at the latest.
