### BACKGROUND

In July 2016, there where 180 trees felled in Mount Arunachala Hill in Tiruvanamalai, to widen Girivalam pathway, despite an interim stay by National Green Tribunal bench on felling trees.

Mostly farmers and natives, who for generations have preserved and protected the scared grooves and forest vegetation of the hill, claimed that contractors are continuing to execute the road widening project by cutting trees indiscriminately, though the district administration on record maintains to have stopped all the work pending further orders from the tribunal.

Sri Joydip Ashram has already worked on 2014 and recommended for protection, of the outstanding cultural and natural environment of Arunachala, in United Nations Global Compact. We have now started a grass root movement to implement our earlier project of *"Protecting the outstanding natural and cultural environment of Arunachala"*.

#### **DEVELOPMENT OF AN ENVIROMENTAL MOVEMENT**

- Problems are identified but public interest is not build.
- Experts and Organizations are already discussing the problems . In this case , Forest Way was working with local government from 2003 and Sri Joydip Ashram was working with United Nations Global Compact with the same problem in 2014.

### Alarm Discovery Stage

- •Environmental problem receives attention of media and therefore noticed by public. And so people have started pressurizing the Government.
- From July 2016 Organization like Daya Ex nora and activist and locals have come together come for protest by Campaign and in NGT.



- People no longer take interest and public interest declines


•The solutions remain unimplemented

Volunteers. Political lobbying for Arunachala Bill and Arunachala Act starts.


15<sup>th</sup> August – Launch of "Digital PR Campaign of Save Girivalam Path"




