I am pleased to advise you that MJ Celco, Inc. has spent the past year supporting the ten guidelines that the Global Compact has outlined with respect to human rights, labor, environment, and anti-corruption. As in the past, we have conveyed to our clients, vendors, and community businesses our strong support of these 10 very important principles. We will, of course, continue our commitment to make a clear statement of this to our stakeholders and the general public annually, as well as adhere to OSHA regulations and national labor standards.

As part of our efforts to support the principles of the Global Compact, we have taken an active interest in the Catholic charity, Stepping Stones Foundation of Hope, a group that is involved in the protection of international human rights and health. Over the past couple of years, we have made monetary donations to help develop the Raphael Clinic in the small village of Bunnamweri, Uganda. MJ Celco has contributed to the purchasing of a water tank, solar panels, a medication refrigerator, and, recently, a generator for this medical facility.

In addition to supporting the above principle, MJ Celco has installed high efficiency lighting in both the Packaging and Welding Departments of our Schiller Park plant.
