1. <u>Health</u>

• Eye Camps using 'Netrajyothi' Mobile Eye care Van (provided by RINL-VSP), were organized.

• Blankets and one year medicines required for the 50 HIV/AIDS affected children of St. Joseph's Children's Home, Prathipadu, and East Godavari District were provided.



- Artificial Limbs were distributed to physically challenged individuals through VMS.
- To bridge the gap of access and provide medical care at the doorstep, CSR dept. conducts medical camps regularly in the surrounding villages of VSP. 1298 patients benefitted out of the several camps conducted in the surrounding villages of VSP as well as mines.



2. Sanitation

 1730 Swachh Bharat "Shram Daan "activities were conducted in the department, mines, township and communities wherein 29497 employees, covering Top Management to lowest grade of employees participated.







1, 30,000 liters per day of Drinking water was supplied through GVMC to four RH colonies & surrounding villages in the summer months (120days).



• 22 RO plants were installed under "Sujala Pathakam" to supply drinking water to 22 villages of Visakhapatnam district.

 25 Bala Swachhta Jagruthi' programmes were organized in schools in surrounding villages of Visakhapatnam steel plant covering 2081 nos. of children.



- Sanitation/Cleanliness campaign was observed in RINL, VSP from 25th Sep.'15 to 31st
 Oct. '15 in line with the Government of India directive.
- Under 'Swachh Visakha' providing of big dumber bins at various locations of Greater Visakha Municipal Corporation has been taken up with GVMC.
- A Stakeholder's meeting was conducted at Nadumveethi, Hamlet of Sukuru near Paderu in Visakhapatnam district to address the comprehensive sanitation needs of the tribal village.



3. Skill Enhancement :

 Project: "Kaushal"- Skill development program for youth belonging to scheduled caste at surrounding areas of VSP has been taken up through Apparel Training Division Centre (ATDC), Visakhapatnam. This program intends to train 200 youth in Garment construction techniques and Industrial sewing machine operation.



 Project "Saksham": Vocational Training classes have been conducted on various trades like LMV driving, Fabric painting, Tailoring, Beautician course etc, at Vadlapudi, Pedagantyada, Gangavaram & Aganampudi RH Colonies, covering 320 unemployed youth & Women.



4. Education

- Project Shiksha: Free education is being provided to 2000 BPL children belonging to the surrounding villages of VSP & mines.
- Adult literacy classes through M/s Pratham Education Foundation have concluded in all the 25 centers in 9 peripheral villages and one tribal village covering 625 adults. Certificates were distributed to the beneficiaries.



- Extended support to 'ARUNODAYA special school in promoting education for the differently abled children.
- "Aakruti": Classroom blocks at Z. P High School, Deshapatrunipalem & M.P.P Madinabaug were renovated and provided with all the basic amenities by Visteel Mahila Samithi.
- "Subhrata": A group hand wash station was constructed at Z. P High School Gajuwaka to enhance the sanitation facilities in the school through Visteel Mahila Samithi.



"Vidya Vikas": Five additional class rooms, entry gate, furniture, etc., provided to ZP High School Gajuwaka Visakhapatnam district, were inaugurated by Hon'ble MLA, Gajuwaka Sri Palla Srinivasa Rao in the presence of CMD & Directors .The additional class room building along with furniture, benefiting 1500 children was handed over to the School Management Committee for utilization. "Vidya Vikas" is an endeavor to bridge the infrastructure gap in the Government Schools.





5. Peripheral Development

• The Reinforced Cement Concrete (RCC) road and Bus Shelter at Chapelapalem, one of the peripheral villages of RINL-VSP, built under "Grama Vikas" initiative were inaugurated by Sri Bandaru Satyanarayana Murthy, Hon'ble MLA, and Pendurthi Constituency.



6. <u>Environment :</u>

• Solar lighting system was provided at St. Joseph's home for the aged The project has led to significant reduction in the Electricity bill, leading to resources available for other requirements like health etc.
