Part II. Description of Actions

LCC International University recently drew together the quality assurance documents, did a self-evaluation report, completed an external evaluation process for Institutional Accreditation in 2016. This review process included an institutional self-report and a site visit by an international group of experts. The judgment from the team of international experts was a positive evaluation of LCC International University and gained full accreditation for 6 years.

LCC actions in support of the Global Compact include:

- Incorporate the UN Global Compact principles into internal operations and communicate progress following the Communication on Progress (COP) requirements;
- Deliver education on topics related to the Global Compact;
- Disseminate the Global Compact principles.

Part III. Measurement of Outcomes

LCC International University provides public annual reports (narrative and financial) based on approved Key Performance Indicators System. LCC is operating in ways that fundamental responsibilities in the areas of human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption would be met. Global Compact's Ten Principles are incorporated into all LCC's educational activities. LCC constantly and regularly implements various surveys with internal and external target groups, which are qualitative and quantitative indicators to measure outcomes of LCC's activities.
