We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual preparation and posting of a Communication on Progress (COP) that comprises of a CEO statement of continued support for the UN Global Compact, a description of practical actions with regard to the principles of the UN Global Compact, and a measurement of outcomes or expected outcomes.

We are late in creating, sharing and posting our COP report due to our two most recent reshuffling among the leadership of Lakou Association added to the recent hurricane catastrophe which recently occurred in Haiti. As a result of this calamity, Lakou Association has had to deploy its short staff to be one of the first responder in the southern region of Haiti to provide emergency services to the victims and is presently in the midst of a continuing fundraising effort to access resources to have the necessary tools to care for those that are seeking aid in that region.
