From 2014 to now, Codes's activities in support of the Global Compact have implemented to empowerment for different groups, including children, youth, student, etc. Specially, street and working children is a main group of us in this period. We have provided resources, both soft and hard tools to supporting for them. All in all, Codes has connected different relationship from individual to organization, State to local in social to enhancing the Children' rights, equality social.

Part III. Measurement of Outcomes

Between the periods of October 2014 to October 2016, Street and working Children and Youth supported by Codes, thought project "A brighter future for Street and Working Children". Beside that, Codes implemented activities related advocacy, events for children and youth. AM PHAT

Main results are as follows:

- Established and running on 06 groups at Codes, including Codes Volunteer (CTN), Child Rights Watch (CTW), Codes Scholarship Program (CSP), Codes Social Work Camp (CSC), Central Vietnam Group (CVG), and Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Trans (ĐCS).
- Finding and social protection for 320 street and working children and youth in Hue city, Thua Thien Hue province.
- Provided scholarships for vocation training and livelihood equipment to enable 28 street and working youth to escape from street life.
- Raising knowledge and skills on child protection resulting from greater livelihood security for 72 street and working families in Thua Thien Hue province.
- Advocating based on evidence related child private rights protection into Vietnam Child law, Vietnam Association law, etc.
- Established a hot line (+84 01295 68 58 68) to consultant and protection on Child's Rights.
- Organized 09 community events for 1.648 children participated.
