


Labor

Environment

- Canon Care Center (CCC) continues its recycling initiatives through Customer Loyalty Program and Canon Recycle Program, where used and worn-out cartridges, toners, digital cameras, printers and scanners are collected from customers and sent to the Electronic Waste Center to be recycled. This was shared in IGCN Member's Gathering on 4 August 2016.
- Energy-efficient lighting and ventilation system are incorporated into Datascrip's main warehouses in Pulogadung and Cikarang.
- Glass walls are used in Datascrip's head office, thus eliminating the need to turn on the lights during daytime.
- As part of Datascrip's initiative to lower its carbon footprint, the HVAC system used in Datascrip Building is only activated Monday through Friday, from 07:00 to 17:30.












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- Principle 9: Encourage the development and diffusion of environmentally friendly technologies.
- Datascrip continually maintains and develops its IT solutions to streamline its business process and progress closer toward a paperless office.
- During 2016, our in-house IT department built two applications to further reduce carbon footprint of our operations.
 - Go-SAM enables Datascrip salespersons to work remotely, thus reducing the time and gasoline wasted in traffic commuting from home to the office.
 - DeTracS allows us to track the detailed status of each order and the exact location of our delivery vehicles thus dramatically increasing the efficiency of the delivery team.
- Datascrip continues its commitment to maintain and introduce environmentallyfriendly products:
 - Auto Power On technology in Canon PIXMA printers saves electricity usage.
 And Canon PIXMA Ink Efficient Printers use refillable ink tanks that eliminate the use of ink cartridge, thus drastically reducing cartridge wastes.
 - Wacom enables user to write on the device, thus minimizing the use of paper.
 We continually educate consumer of this technology by replacing guest registration with Wacom in events that we held.
 - Many of our Maped products are made from recycled materials.









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- Datascrip participated in the IGCN's initiative, "Save Water Campaign" starting from mid of 2013. The stickers are installed throughout Datascrip's offices and warehouses.
- As part of our growing concerns for the environment, Datascrip is ISO 14001 (environmental management) certified.
- Matahari Alka, a part of Datascrip's group of companies, is one of the Circle Founder
 of Green Product Council Indonesia (GPCI) which is an independent, non-profitorganization and voluntary scheme for the certification of environmentally
 preferable products.
- Datascrip is also a member of Green Building Council Indonesia (GBCI), an independent body which is fully committed to educate the public of environmental best practices and to facilitate the transformation of the sustainable building industry.












Anti-Corruption
