Civiliti promotes EcoArt to create awareness, stimulate dialogue, and encourage the long-term respect for the natural systems with which we coexist. In a very direct manner, Civiliti promotes these artisans fundamentally incorporating the history, the community and the stories with the environment and/or human rights in their actual work product or in the related knowledge.

Civiliti provides responsible global citizens with opportunities to support shared values while bringing both beauty and knowledge into their lives and those with whom they interact. Civiliti increases exposure of EcoArt and provides an outlet for EcoArtists to explain their work, their history and their stories while helping share environmental and human rights knowledge, including direct links to appropriate information in the Civiliti Knowledge Centers.

Civiliti utilizes three Knowledge Centers. The Environmental Knowledge Center, the Human Rights Knowledge Center and the EcoArt Academy to support learning and as such, support the Global Compact Principles and Goals.

All the above exemplifies why Civiliti is – in and of itself – a vehicle, an instrument – supporting the United Nations Global Compact, its Principles, its Goals . EcoArt – embedded in its meaning – is the belief, the understanding and the practice of preserving sustainability ... equality ... in the environment and human rights, thus supporting knowledge development in the fundamentals behind the Global Compact.

This Olympics-style academic collaboration focuses on advancing knowledge to middle-aged and high school-aged students in a manner engaging to them with hopeful ties to universities around the world with scholarships for participants. Global agreements for distribution via the Internet have also been accomplished in order to publicly launch this effort.
