1. Action taken on Corruption, Crime Prevention and Drug Abuse, Seminar and campaign

We hope that new tool for finding resources to help young people lead healthy lives and avoid substance abuse. It will also help parents, families, teachers, practitioners, community leaders and policy makers globally to find relevant materials to support their work to lead happy and healthy lives. We emphasizes coordinated, comprehensive response to the interrelated issues of illicit trafficking in and abuse of drugs, crime prevention and criminal justice, terrorism, and corruption. We pursue our activities to achieve our goals through our legal team for advocacy, consultation and support to face their respective situations with challenge. We have organized different meetings, training camps, Workshops to spread out the public awareness and our Lawyers team monitoring and observing the situation to control it as and when needed.







2. Campaign, Seminar and monitoring program on HIV/AIDS

HIV and AIDS is one of the biggest challenges before our NGO and overall to the society as a whole. The rate of infection is rapidly increasing and more and more people are getting ill and dying from AIDS. South Africa has one of the fastest growing rates of infection in the world. Individuals, families and communities are badly affected by the epidemic.

The fight against AIDS has to happen on two main fronts - prevention and care. To prevent the spread of AIDS we have to educate people on how to prevent infection. We also have to change the social attitudes that make women vulnerable because they cannot refuse unsafe sex from a partner and the attitudes among men that lead to woman abuse and rape. Poverty alleviation and development are also important programmes that will limit the spread of AIDS. We are actively involve to campaign, Slogans and message, Public education, Awareness raising, support and care for people living with AIDS, Community care for orphans, Motivating others to get involved.

One of our project on HIV/AIDS regarding "Mobile Health Care and Campaign Program are on process

SYMPTOMS

When HIV emerges from latency (the period when someone with HIV shows no signs of it) symptoms can include:

- Dry, flaky skin (Xeroderma)
- Chronic fatigue
- Fever that comes and goes (Pyrexia)
- Diarrhea that lasts more than a week
- Heavy night sweats (Hyperhidrosis)
- Rapid weight loss
- Swollen lymph nodes
- White spots on tongue, mouth & throat

We are handling different legal matters for infringement of Consumer Protection law before the Consumer Redressed Forum

and some cases we advise the consumers to solve the dispute amicably. We have organized locally Public Awareness program and visited many business shops and general public to consult regarding the way of purchasing and sale of commodities. We have suggested them not to purchase or transfer / sale, etc. of any goods and articles without any genuine Cash Memo / Chillan's, etc. We are attached with our Hon'ble judges of District Consumer Forum and consulting with them and receiving advice regarding different critical affairs of consumers and how to solve it. Accordingly, we can guide the better way to solve the redress of the consumers.





5. Human Rights Training, Seminar and practical action on necessary fields.

It is admitted that the promotion and protection of human rights is a matter of priority for the international community and all human rights derive from the dignity and worth inherent in the human person based on the principles enshrined in the Charter of the United Nations, including promoting and encouraging respect for human rights and fundamental freedoms for all. All human rights are universal, indivisible and interdependent and interrelated.

To focus the objects of the World Conference, we have taken into consideration the human rights education, training and public information system to be continued through our NGO for the promotion and achievement of stable and harmonious relations among communities and for fostering mutual understanding, tolerance, peace, democracy, development and social justice with a view to lengthening universal commitment to human rights. Regularly we are receiving different programs, messages, reports and articles and sending many comments, submitting Feedbacks and messages, etc. We are getting Invitations for different programs and Seminars from Geneva, Austria, USA, etc. We are also actively involved with Australian Human Rights and many other International organizations and receives Invitations on many occasions and regular messages, reports of their activities and programs.






6. Women and Child Development Programme:

Our Org. every year convening a Literacy camp and we are organizing one weekly classes for Children, youth and adult illiterate persons in our Head Office.



9. **Physically Challenged & Unemployment Group**: We are connecting some business offices and industry to create some employment oriented program. We have applied to the Ministry of Labour to run industrial training with the help of Govt. of West Bengal. We are working with children and adults who have developmental and other disabilities. As a Resource Centre for People with Special Needs, we provide early intervention services, education, livelihoods development, training and awareness.


