Repsol E&P Bolivia S.A. is committed to promoting the Ten Principles of the Global Pact. We subscribed to this initiative in 2007 and carried out actions that have permitted us to contribute to the objectives in four thematic areas.

We accessioned independently from our home office and in the past few years have continued promoting and executing actions that benefit our employees, communities that are nearby our operations and Bolivian society as a whole, always acting within the framework of values and principles adopted by the Company worldwide.

We are convinced – as noted by the United Nations – that we can help create a sustainable and integrating global economy that will contribute to the greater welfare of society as a whole.
