DXC France Grace Period Letter

To our stakeholders:

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual preparation and posting of a Communication on Progress (COP) that comprises of a statement of continued support for the UN Global Compact, a description of practical actions regarding the principles of the UN Global Compact, and a measurement of outcomes or expected outcomes.

In April 2017, CSC and HPE Enterprise Services (ES) joined forces to launch DXC Technology, the world's leading independent, end-to end IT services provider, with \$25 billion in annual revenues and 170,000 employees. This implies many changes and updates, which explains why we will need an extension to create, share and post our COP report due on September 13, 2017.

We hereby ask for an extension period in order to be able to post a COP that describes DXC France's efforts and progress to implement the principles of the UN Global Compact.

Our new COP report will be posted on the UN Global Compact website by December 12, 2017 at the latest.
