- Solidarity Entity Prize 2016, XII ABC Solidarity Prizes. Santa María la Real del Patrimonio Histórico Foundation was awarded as Solidarity Entity in recognition for the work carried out through about forty decades in generating employment and development. This work has been intensified in the last years by the setting up of the Employment Launching Program.
- In the context of crisis in Spain, with high percentages of unemployment, the Santa María la Real Foundation has opted for the creation of **social programmes** that help people to join or rejoin the labor market:
 - Employment and Solidarity Entrepreneurship Launching Programmes: 7000 participants, and 50% of labor insertion
 - Castilla y León Women Employment Programme PEMCYL: This programme has as its main objective the insertion of women at risk of social exclusion or in special situations and vulnerability through the improvement of their employability and the accompaniment in their job search. 30 % of labour insertion.
