## Influencing Minds of students: Academic Curricula

The Institute teaches a compulsory course “Responsible Business” to all its admitted students pursuing different management programmes at the Institute. The course delves upon issues of responsibility, sustainability and ethics in business. This is done with a belief that underscoring and discussing issues pertaining to Responsible Business conduct in Management curricula helps the students be discerning professionals.

Towards this aim: An integrated course comprising of modules on Sustainability and Sustainable development, Corporate Governance, Business and Professional Ethics, Corporate Social Responsibility(CSR), Corporate Social Responsibility from a Human Rights' perspective as well as a sound knowledge of Principles, Standards, Frameworks and codes of conduct applicable in the domain are imparted to the students. These modules are set in the context of evolution of business and evolution of expectations of society from business globally as well as applicable in India.

### Special Lectures

An important component built into the CSR module is the practitioners' and expert perspective'. It is brought to the students in the classroom by inviting over thought leaders, reputed practitioners and experts in the field of CSR, social and development sectors, governments and the like for 'expert lecture series on CSR.' The students also attend and participate in CSR-related events like conferences, seminars, public discourses etc.

The process of expert lecture series on CSR was started in 2007, aided by Business and Community Foundation, one of BIMTECH's partners in its CSR endeavours. Deliberations and discussions on life, humanity, religion etc form part of the Forum “Success and Happiness” which helps students attain consciousness beyond the limits of their own existence. Spiritual Leaders like His Holiness Sri Sri Ravi Shankar and His Holiness, the Dalai Lama, eminent persons like Mr Prakash Amte, Ms Kiran Bedi, Padmabhushan Dr Bindeshwar Pathak, Founder, Sulabh Sanitation etc. have graced the students with their presence.

## Influencing Behaviour

The Responsible Business course has been integrated with an experienced based learning through "Community Immersion Programme". The students are taken for a visit to nearby villages as well as CSR project sites (usually villages) of some of the corporate. Also, the students may choose to work on Social projects as part of compulsory short-term projects undertaken by students during the course of their study. The students are assisted to be hand-held by companies, foundations and NGOs with which the Institute has a relationship with. Newer organisations come in touch with BIMTECH each year and these associations broaden the base for students to choose and work with organisations of their liking.

### Social Projects' Experiential Learning (Batch 2017-19)

The students were exposed to almost 15 villages spread across Haryana, Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh as part of this experiential learning, this year.

The students interacted with CSR heads and field officers of the companies while visiting their CSR Project Intervention sites as well as with the

Village Panchayat Heads, gram pradhans, members of the community and targeted beneficiaries (of CSR projects of Companies).

The Villages visited were in the Gautam Buddha Nagar District of Uttar Pradesh viz. Neemka Shahjanpur and Khwajpur as also the villages where the project intervention sites of SRF Foundation, Maruti Suzuki Ltd and NTPC Ltd were located. These villages were in district Nuh in Haryana, Alwar in Rajasthan and district Gautam Buddha Nagar in Uttar Pradesh.

The students interacted both formally and informally with various stakeholders of the company associated with their CSR projects of sanitation, education, infrastructure, health and poverty alleviation. The exposure helped students gain significant insights into the social landscape of our country as well as the efforts of companies undertaking CSR projects, as per the mandate of Indian Companies Act.

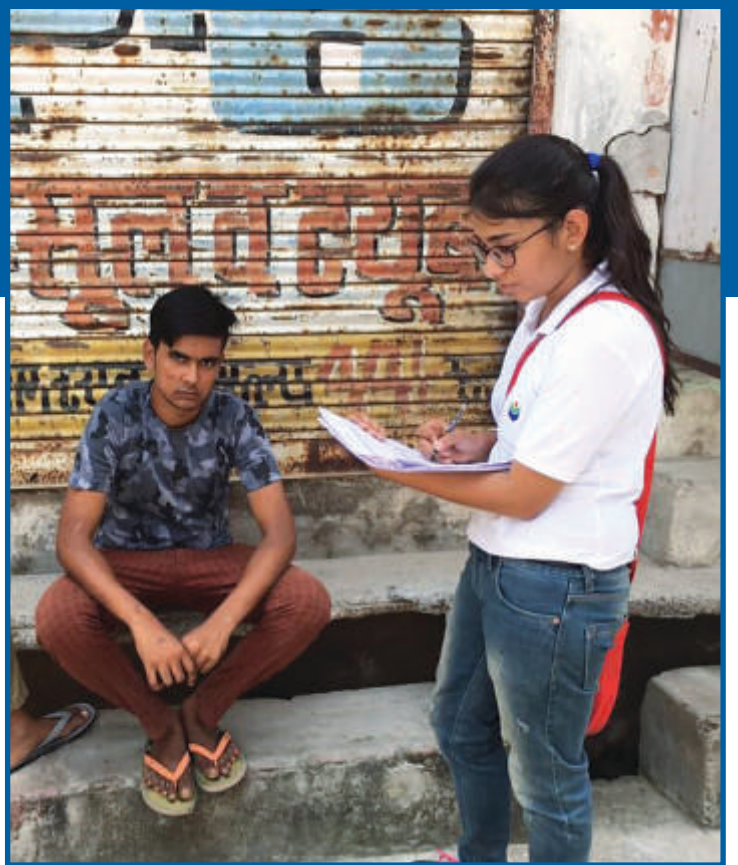

## Student Forums

With an aim to reinforce responsible behaviour amongst students, several forums are running at the Institute. The students work and engage in ideas and activities based on themes of environment sustainability, sensitivity towards diverse groups, underserved and underprivileged communities and so on. The students while working with each other enjoy themselves as it is a good way for them to connect with each other, develop long term relationship and contribute to a congenial environment at the Institute, nonetheless they are encouraged and advised to be sensitive and caring towards each other and people whom they are engaging with while being ethical in their conduct.

### The Social Entrepreneur

An inter-college event that sees a good and an active participation from other B-Schools in the country. The teams are assigned sites in the neighbouring villages of Greater Noida which have issues of poor sanitation, water logging, waste disposal, drinking water and the like. The teams are asked to analyze the grievances and come up with business models which could offer solutions to these problems.

### Planestia

It conducts events to promote environmental and Biodiversity consciousness amongst students. Various methods like debating, chart competitions, Group Discussions, Quizzing, watching video films and movies are used for this purpose.

### Greenathon

This is a flagship event of UFE where various themes such as "save water" illiteracy, waste management etc. are highlighted by students and concern over these issues promoted through interesting messages, skits, Flash Mobs etc.

### Earth Hour and Environment Day Celebration

This is an initiative undertaken by students every year where they join hands to save electricity by switching off all the lights and electrical appliances in their hostel rooms for an hour as their commitment to celebrating the Earth Hour on 24th March 2017. The students also celebrate the world environment day on 5th June of every year.

### WOW Campaign

The WOW campaign undertaken by the Food Conduit Committee in co-ordination with other Conduits and Clubs at BIMTECH aims at reducing in wastage of food served in the campus. This one-week long campaign results in not only emphasising and sensitising the BIMTECH fraternity to the menace of food wastage but also leads to substantial reduction of wastage of food during this period.

### PGDM Programme in Sustainable Development Practices

In 2010, the Institute launched PGDM Programme in Sustainable Development Practices.

The course was modelled on the recommendations of International Commission on Education for Sustainable Development Practice and customized to local conditions. The courses offered by the centre focussed on different dimensions of CSR. The subjects included Responsible Business, Sustainability, Business Ethics, Social Innovation and Entrepreneurship.

BIMTECH has been conferred Gold Award for its PGDM (Sustainable Development Practices) programme. This programme was judged best among all entries in on the theme "Effective Engagement between Industry and Institute" during International Management Conclave organized by MBA Universe from 2-3 August 2013 at New Delhi. The award was given by Dr Shashi Tharoor the then Hon'ble Minister of State HRD, Govt. of India.

## Towards Creating Educational Frameworks, Materials, Processes and Environments that enable Effective Learning Experiences for Responsible Leadership

In its role as an academic Institution, BIMTECH strives to contribute towards Creating Educational Frameworks, Materials, Processes and Environments that would enable Effective Learning Experiences for Responsible Leadership.

Through its partnerships with institutions and organisations which are working in the domain of sustainability, responsible business and CSR, it facilitates and supports dialogue and debate among educators, business, government, consumers, media, civil society organizations, and other interested groups and stakeholders on critical issues related to global social responsibility and sustainability.

Through its Consultancy and Advisory services, the Institute serves to extend its knowledge to managers of business corporations in meeting their challenges of social and environmental responsibilities by jointly exploring effective approaches.

Conceptual and empirical research advances the Institute's own understanding about the role, dynamics, and impact of corporations in the creation of sustainable social, environmental and economic value and to disseminate it to the larger public.









## Partnerships

### Partnership with Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce and Industry (FICCI)

The Institute has partnered with FICCI in conducting on-site assessments of CSR initiatives by Indian Corporate for the FICCI Annual CSR Awards and Supports and participates in Korea- India CSR Forum, a bilateral forum between FICCI and the Embassy of the Republic of Korea in India, providing a platform to exchange and share ideas related to CSR between policymakers, academics, and businesses of the two countries.

The FICCI CSR awards have been organised for more than a decade now and have a three-tier assessment method led by three different groups of independent assessors. The first phase of the assessment is carried out by Grant Thornton

India, a reputed International Accounting and Auditing firm which selects the entries for a physical verification, the second assessment is done by visiting the CSR -Project sites of the companies and assessing it, this process is undertaken by BIMTECH; the third phase of the assessment is selection of the entries for awards by an independent jury.

The Awards are given away at a high-profile event marked in its attendance by Eminent members from the Government, Companies, media, civil society and other Government and non-Government organisations from different parts of the country.

The Award function is preceded by a series of events, the most prominent amongst them is Korea-India CSR Forum.

### Partnership with Indian Institute of Corporate Affairs (IICA)

The Indian Institute of Corporate Affairs (IICA), a premiere agency under Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Government of India launched its nine months' IICA Certificate Programme (ICP) in CSR in October 2014 to prepare a cadre of skilled CSR professionals.

BIMTECH was selected as one of the training partners from institutions all over the country. A batch of ten participants, comprising of senior executives from companies like BHEL, ONGC, HCL and others, were allocated to the BIMTECH study centre for the course. The programme commenced on 23rd October 2014 and Ms Surabhi Yadav, from BIMTECH topped the course in India.

### Partnership with Global Reporting Initiative (GRI)

The Institute supports the goals and objectives of GRI as its organisational Stakeholder.

### Partnership with Global Compact Network Society in India and the Global Compact

The Institute collaborates on several advocacy and capacity building activities of the UNGCNI<sup>1</sup> and is a permanent member.

### Partnership with National HRD Network

The Institute has long standing relationship with the National HRD Network and collaborates in many areas including the cause of Responsible Business and CSR. Its most prominent joint activity is organising the Annual National CSR Summit and Best CSR Case Studies' Contest.

### Partnership with Thinkthrough Consulting (TTC)

An MoU was signed between BIMTECH and TTC on 16th of August 2017 to deepen the Institute's footprint of Responsible Business and CSR. Think through Consulting offers advisory services in areas such as Sustainability and Climate Change, Ethical Business, CSR and HR. It is quite a name to reckon with in this domain both nationally and internationally.

The partnering organisations have agreed to collaborate on conducting trainings, workshops, seminars etc. for BIMTECH students and third parties on compliance to the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal Act, 2013) and other empowering provisions for women at the workplace.

### Partnership with Yunus Centre

BIMTECH has signed MoU with the Yunus Centre for promoting the agenda of social business.

### Partnership with Public and Private Sector Corporations

The Institute is regularly invited by the private and public-sector corporations to deliver management development programmes and training programmes for their executives. MoUs with large scale corporations like National Thermal Power Corporation Ltd (NTPC), Steel Authority of India (SAIL), Oil and Natural Gas Corporation (ONGC), Indian Farmers Fertilisers Cooperative (IFFCO) also facilitate such joint efforts.

### Network Partnerships

Apart from the formal partnerships as mentioned above, the Institute also works along with and contributes to the efforts of some of the most reputed organizations in the domain of Responsible Business and CSR. International Business Leaders Forum (UK), CSR Asia (Hong Kong), Business and Community Foundation (India) Emergent Ventures, PHD Chambers etc. are some such organisations.

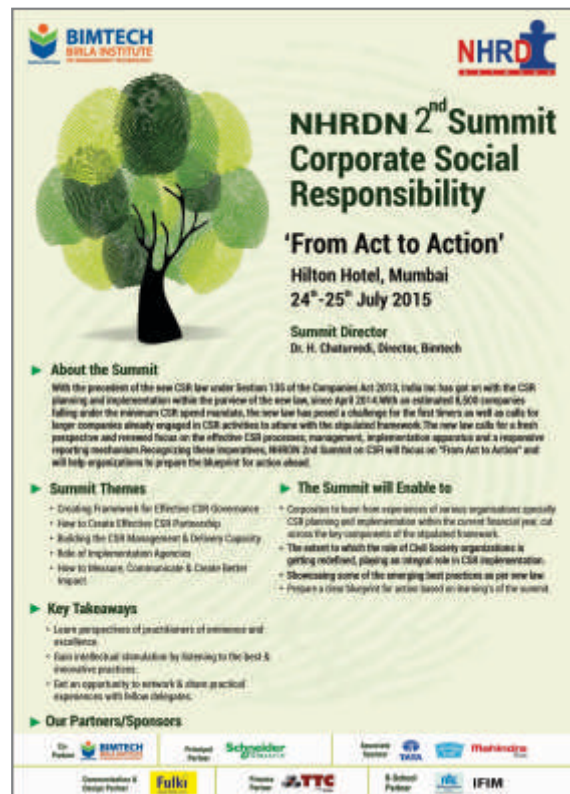

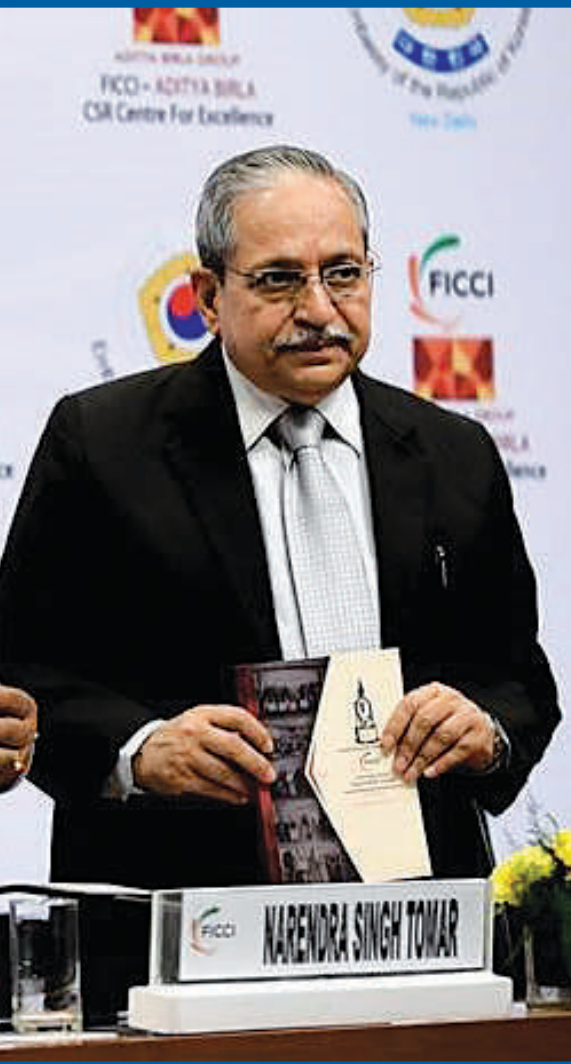

## Project Protsahan Chiraiyya

Project "Protsahan Chiraiyya" is a rural social project on women empowerment started by the Society at Neemka Shajahanpur, Jewar Tehsil, UP. This village is adopted by the Hon'ble Union Minister of Culture and local MP, Dr. Mahesh Sharma under the Sansad Adarsh Gram Vikas Yojna. The project was launched with the vision to sensitize the rural underprivileged adolescent girls about all aspects of good quality life, education, health as well as their roles in the community. The pilot phase of this project was flagged off on 28th March, 2016 to commemorate the first death anniversary of Dr. Sarla Devi Birla, "Founding member of BIMTECH".

The project is spread over several stages called Chiraiyya Kaushal, Chahek, Agradoot, Samwaad and Udaan. The first phase starts with the selection of 30 adolescent girls from lower strata of society (called Chiraiyya, a small sparrow in early stages of learning who once provided necessary support can develop confidence to spread her wings and fly with fervour) who are administered a 17 weeks' capsule of Life Skill education. The 2nd stage called Chahek, imparts a Basic English Education (BEE) programme. In the third stage, the students become the torch-bearers of the Project (Called Agradoots, trained Chiraiyya who as an ambassador will spread the message and spread the message of the project to other girls in the community). The fourth stage provides them an opportunity of interaction with a dignitary and the fifth stage sees these girl students lead a more confident life with support from the Society.

RSSWLD has continued to increase the outreach of its "Project Protsahan Chiraiyya", as on date 150 girls have taken course on "life skills" while 60 girls have attended the course on English speaking.

The fourth and fifth batches of Project Chiraiya were launched on 6th May 2017 and 17th September 2017 respectively. After the successful completion of the project in Neemka village, the RSSWLD has plans to replicate the project in other villages nearby.
