# Period covered by this Communication on Engagement

December, 2015—November, 2017

#### **Mission**

Sustainable Development Organization, located in the heart of India, New Delhi, established in November 2015, is a not-for-profit Registered Society with a mission to create awareness through discussions, deliberation, seminars, debates etc. regarding sustainability and environmental development study in general and awakening in particular among wide strata of society.

Its aims to promote environmental and social education among the different communities specially minorities communities through short term and medium-term training-cum-awareness programs especially in rural areas of the country and to organize relief camps for the people affected either by natural calamities like flood, earthquakes, cyclones etc or by communal violence and to work for their rehabilitation and to provide medical assistance to the affected people.

## **Description of actions**

Sustainable Development Organization is wholly aligned with the UNGC and engaged in many activities that we hope and expect will support its flourishing. Few major activities in the last two years are as under:

- ❖ Sustainable Development Organization decided with its members and stakeholders to celebrated world awareness days including Ozone Day, Earth Day, Environmental Day etc. every year. First celebration for Ozone Day was held in Bihar. In this awareness programme, a quiz competition was held among local school students from class III to 10<sup>th</sup> standard. - ❖ SDO also runs a school free of cost for basic education for minority student. This school is situated at Katihar District in Bihar (India). Besides Islamic education, English, Hindi, Urdu and Arabic are being taught there. Students are being given basic education in this school. Total five well qualified teachers are teaching in the school.
- ❖ SDO has many other activities in the past two years through field work and social networking sites to support ten principles of UNGC in the areas of Human Rights,



Labour, Environment and Anti-Corruption. SDO has a facebook page and a group to make awareness through digital resources.
