Furthermore SUGECO work with 3,000 smallholder farmers in Kilosa and Gairo districts, promoting Good agricultural practices for Orange Fleshed Sweet Potatoes (OFSP) and its nutritional benefits to community Support formalization of market arrangements for high-performing smallholders and farmer groups to increase predictability for both them and processors, building good business practices and profitability at the same time in Promoting the nutritional benefits of OFSP and how to cook.
