TEAM 1 - represented by Paul Ruffin

"Communiversity"

Initial Challenge:

Transitional

Diversity

Job Creation

Take today's Economy and transition it....Use the

TEAM 2 – represented by J.R. Johnson / Eugene Shirley

Pando Market creates a new barter market, not based on \$\$ economy but based on precapitalistic goods distribution. Extra stuff plus entertainment = repurposing & sharing.

There are lots of "leftovers" (food, furniture, etc.) that can be reused instead of discarded.

Create connections to provide a corporate channel for excess of goods and needs such as labor. Provide DIY opportunities & education. No dollars are exchanged; your currency is you skill.

- Classes
- Events
- Healthy Restaurant

Each Market has to serve a particular, local geography.

TEAM 3 - represented by Joe Conner

"Why?" joins the community together. Every idea has to be circular, coming back around to sustain. Regardless of where you start in the project, you join the whole:

- Skill / talent
- · Support, through technology, providing resources, Ted talks, documentation
- Relaxation
- Production

The focal point is FPYF, promoting environmental and technical methods that are spread through media. Making money is a key goal.

TEAM 4 - represented by Alex Malloy

This concept is a youth camp for the victims of violence, whether gun violence or domestic violence. The focus is on healing and coping through storytelling and nature. Youth who come through the camp become mentors for the community as they heal and mature.

TEAM 5 - represented by Wayne Fishback

"This Place L.A."

- 1) Impact
 - a. FPYF can increase the impact through Education
 - Amer-I-Can is a critical partner
- 2) Revenue
- Reforming the way things are done can produce revenue, e.g., bringing materials from demolition sites. CalGreen initiative requires that 65% of all materials have to be recycled. This can be a business.
- ii. E-commerce from project to project is sustainable
- Food / Recycling / Other
 - a. Community gardens can be a revenue stream

Any program has to give people a sense of their own strength.

TEAM 6 - represented by Hugo Perez / Amanda Bonilla

"Art & Soul" - mobile education unit.

Build bridges between communities. Let them learn from each other, and it will help to combine them into a better environment. Celebrate diversity!

TEAM 7 – represented by Marcos Beltran

1 Radius focuses on homelessness. Architecture helps maintain facilities that have been abandoned, can create an urban family that can be turned into labs and serve the population.

River Labs have helped with the allocation of land from the city for specific purposes. If we spread this idea into homeless shelters, we should be able to provide shelter within a mile radius of where the need is.

TEAM 8 - represented by Brad Carson / John Bollinger / Anthony Vasquez / Nery Cividanis

Urban Eco Farms: The model is food coops, where 1 member = 1 vote. A member gets an equity share through time, talent or taxes.

The Alley is a joint venture between the residents of the community and the participants who need the support. The project needs to be 1) sustainable; 2) replicable; 3) scaleable, so the 5,000 alleys that were closed after the riots can benefit from the model.

There needs to be considerable outreach to break the cycle of poverty (lack of economic opportunity), which leads to not being educated, which leads to more crime and then more poverty. The project needs to turn Unemployment to Employment; Lack of Education to Education.

Anthony talked about gardens = jobs, from fish nutrients to drip irrigation.

John B's focus is production: tying everything together to grow into a more stable whole.

Nery's focus is distribution of product.

TEAM 9 - represented by Ricardo Chavez / Les Hamasaki

"Hub Nursery" to be converted from old warehouses. Would create training and jobs for local people. Emphasis would be on reducing waste, using what we have. For example, cuttings from existing / excess plants could be sold for \$4 each, earning money for the hub at a price that is affordable.

The nursery would be a sort of genetics laboratory, where people could learn to recycle waste as mulch and find other innovative solutions to urban problems.

Training sites don't have to be centralized or large; micro sites can be leased or rented throughout the city. Hydroponics can be started in apartments, schools, and churches.

TEAM 10 – represented by Eugene Shirley / Pando Populus

"Rejuvenate L.A."

Use the government land to serve veterans by creating jobs for the future, transitioning from military. Create jobs for the mind, body and soul by using vacant properties as "skills incubators." Provide co-working space. Space can be used to host start-up opportunity jobs, and to provide education to hone individual skills and to learn technology skills. Teach to write resumes, gain other types of useful information that can be used in existing and new ways.





Agenda 2063</u>, <u>International Decade for Peoples of African Descent</u> and 400th commemoration of the "<u>First Arrival of Africans</u>" in 2019.
- To encourage and promote effective public, public-private and civil society partnerships, building on the experience and resourcing strategies of partnerships, including <u>Freelancer</u>, <u>Home-Based</u>, <u>Micro- and Small-Medium-Enterprise</u> businesses [emphasis added].

We are recruiting and growing a strategic alliance throughout the Diaspora to identify and register 4,000+ civil society stakeholders (ngos, nonprofits, business associations, labor organizations, academic institutions and cities) and 1,000 new, small and medium-sized enterprises to the United Nations Global Compact to build a Caring 4 Climate worldwide community resiliency network.
