 - .Also we help in Maintaining the schools effected for the typhoons, and crisis due to terrorism like in Marawi city in south Philippines, sometimes we help in building the schools
 - We also help them with new trends of education subjects, like teach them human rights, democracy ...etc. through our PEP program
 - Outcomes of the program:
 - More than 200,000 student return back to schools, know that they are not slaves, they do have the right to live with dignity till now over 850.000 school bag & tools till now and still in progress this was the support of the National Youth Committee in Philippines.

Brief about PWL TV: PWL TV is the first kind of channel for an international development organization, it's scheduled launched to be on 2nd December 2016 using Supreme SAT. 




