Reporting Cycle Adjustment,

To whom it may concern,

Tundra Fonder is proud to support the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact on human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. We express our intent to implement those principles and are committed in our work to meet expectations.

Tundra fonder has already been implementing these principles into our business for years and we are in the process of updating our reporting on these actions. We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress (COP) that describes our company's efforts to implement the Ten Principles. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress within one year of joining the UN Global Compact, and annually thereafter according to the UN Global Compact COP policy. This includes:

We are currently working with our annual sustainability report and evaluation of a new ESG rating system. As a certified Swedish Ecolabel we also have to adhere to guidelines from the Nordic Ecolabel which we would like to include in our COP. Therefore we ask for adjust our reporting cycle and submit our COP by April 30th. Our COP will include:

- A statement signed by the chief executive expressing continued support for the UN Global Compact and renewing our ongoing commitment to the initiative and its principles. This is separate from our initial letter of commitment to join the UN Global Compact.
- A description of practical actions (i.e., disclosure of any relevant policies, procedures, activities) that the company has taken (or plans to undertake) to implement the UN Global Compact principles in each of the four issue areas (human rights, labour, environment, anti-corruption).
- A measurement of outcomes (i.e., the degree to which targets/performance indicators were met, or other qualitative or quantitative measurements of results).
