By taking the lead to help the United Nations Environment Program (UNEP) efforts to partner with non-government organizations and corporations who will help “catalyze change among [U.N.] member states” on environmental issues; install principles of “ecosystem management” and “environmental sustainability”

### **MISSION:**

Working together with principals, school counselors, parent/guardians to provide Middle and High Schools students’ data on negative impact of alcohol and drug use to create Safe and Drug-Free Schools and Communities.

Provide mobility for older adults and people with mobility impairment or limited strength.

To help Churches and houses of worship to:

- promote and enhance traditional ministries and facilitate the spreading and translation of the gospel.
- ensure automatic display of Bible passages, sermons, hymns, announcements in both English and a second language.
- increase understanding in both English and non-English speaking members through means of computers, electronic screens and learning labs.

Working with community and government agencies to eliminate the disparity in access to basic needs to promote reduction in illiteracy, ignorance and make education affordable and accessible to all families by:

- collection and re-distribution of basic items such as books, computers, soccer/ basket balls and equipment, athletic shoes and gear, school backpacks and school bags, multivitamins, diapers, bibles, toys, educational games/materials, clothes, SMART Board interactive whiteboard, and science equipment for children in need to ensure a physically and emotionally healthy development.

Through our Partnership with [Good360](#), we have impacted more than 500 families in the South Bronx. UBNLINKS FOUNDATION continues to work in Abakeliki, Ebonyi State, Nigeria Orodo ,Imo State Nigeria which has the highest cases of childhood malnutrition in Nigeria.

We have assisted in the training of persons to work as educators and demonstrators of good nutritional practices and supported programs for the education and training of mothers during pregnancy and after the birth of their children in Nigeria through our hospital, EPHY Hospital Abuja, Nigeria, so that good nutritional habits can be formed at an early age. We have also donated over 10 cartons of multivitamins to children under 5 and pregnant and lactating women in Bronx, Ghana and Nigeria.

We are committed to increasing the accessibility of soccer and basket balls in West Africa, Bronx K-12 public schools and Faith based organizations that run after school programs, creating sustainable projects that leave a lasting legacy and supporting local youth programs that will encourage children to live a healthy and active lifestyle.

UBNLINKS FOUNDATION in collaboration with Right-to-Write has donated over 5000 pens and pencils to elementary schools in United States and Nigeria.

We are also working in Ghana through our "Fit to move" project. We have assisted the Nyohini Children's Home in Northern Ghana
