## **Part II. Description of Action**

In the pursuit of our objectives to promote the social dialogue and the integration of the most impoverished communities in the Congo to help them to become self-sufficient, to strengthen the means of raising awareness of access to education and to inform on the importance of peace and to live together in a post-conflict country. We also multiplied entrepreneurship training for economic management of target populations.

We pursue our mission in liaison with grassroots community cells, coordinates planning efforts to eradicate extreme poverty and hunger, providing technical expertise, and facilitating the development of community social work.

The majority of our activities happen in the field. Achieving our goals, we have worked with communities, faith-based and civic organizations, government officials and private entities, and has worked to ensure that Supported people, regardless of their ethnicity, political and religious, or gender, can achieve self-sufficiency and success in the economic life of Congolese society. Our principal method was to promote access to training and education everywhere and for all.

Our training has allowed our beneficiaries to benefit fully and to be fully involved in the UN Global Compact. Among the actions, there are:

- **Support to micro social enterprises and education**

The secret to the success of any organization and any human enterprise lies in the composition of its members. Moreover, as the behavior of a person influences those around them, the ripple effect occurs and ultimately transforms everyone and everything it touches. For two years, CongOrganize provided educational workshops and consulting services in the areas of Human Resources, Corporate Social Responsibility, Leadership, and Community Development.

For two years, we worked on a project for free primary education by supporting 300 orphans and vulnerable children from poor communities in Kinshasa (Congo). We supported 50 community and community projects for women. For the year 2018, CongOrganize will begin its program of economic self-sufficiency and promote job creation through the granting of micro-credits.

- **Youth Forum for Development, Kinshasa, December 2016**

The vision of this forum was to supervise young people to take charge of their work. It is for this reason that we have implemented the development projects, the youth seminars during which we teach young people to work or to learn business such as masonry, agriculture, cutting, and sewing. We have collaborated with Emi Consulting and other specialized professional centers.

### **Part III. Measurement of Outcomes**

- Local associations, partners of Congorganize, were informed of the installation of the local network of UN Global Compact in the Democratic Republic of the Congo. They got involved and made a strong commitment to supporting the efforts of the local network to promote the principles of UN Global Compact finally.
- CongOrganize has continued its mission in liaison with grassroots community cells, coordinating planning efforts to eradicate extreme poverty and hunger, providing technical expertise in the areas of Human Resources, Corporate Social Responsibility, and facilitating the community development. It is this environment of exchanges that allowed us to understand better and promote the principles of UN Global Compact and invite our partner associations to support them.

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
