Dear Mr. Secretary General,

I am pleased to confirm Natixis strong support to the UN Global Compact international initiative, and its commitment to the improvement of the 10 principals regarding human rights, labor, environment and anti-corruption.

As a key financier of the economy, Natixis has a role to play in the transition to sustainable development, and decided in 2017 to further its Environmental and Social Responsibility (ESR) ambitions: ESR is one of the main cross-business drivers used to achieve the goals of our 2018-2020 "New Dimension" strategic plan. It is backed by enhanced governance, with the establishment of a dedicated department reporting directly to a member of the Senior Management Committee. Natixis ESR policy rests on three structure-building pillars: onboarding and direct-impacts management, risk management and the development of sustainable businesses.

Natixis is also mindful of its role to contributing to the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) adopted by the 193 Member States of the United Nations. Natixis identified 8 SDGs to which it has already made a material contribution, one that is set to expand in the years to come, through financing and investments as well as in its daily operation.

In 2017, Natixis also drafted its Code of Conduct, an umbrella document guiding employees in their relations with the company's stakeholders: our customers, teams, shareholders, as well as the general society at large. The goal is for each employee to act with the highest professional ethics and a keen sense of responsibility, notably by embracing Natixis' environmental and social responsibility commitments. The Code of Conduct stresses that Natixis endeavors to meet environmental challenges and to make a positive social and societal impact.

The information presented in the Natixis 2017 Registration document corresponds to our Communication on Progress for 2017. It reflects Natixis contribution to sustainable growth and describes our commitment and concrete achievements in favor of the Global Compact principles.
