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## **Part II. Description of Actions**

4.10.2016 - Global Compact Poland, as part of the continuation of activities related to the consumption of sustainable palm oil, together with RSPO (Roundtable on Sustainable Palm Oil) and with the support of the Polish Chamber of Commerce organized a consultation meeting on the Polish road to working out standards for palm oil consumption.

29.06.2017 – Attract new participants to the UN Global Compact through organizing debate about Global Compact principles during PCC council.

12.06.2017 – Organize workshops and training for PCC's members on the UN Global Compact and specific topics relevant to corporate sustainability (Conference: Abuse in VAT)

June 2018 - Establishment of a committee on innovation, technology and diversity - responsible for i.e. searching for solutions that would allow more equal distribution of work, tasks, responsibilities, positions and remuneration between representatives of both genders, of more and less developed regions, and between specialists in various areas of business, high-tech, basic sciences and humanities.
