- Have added a Sustainability Science as the 9th grade science course
- Diversifying curriculum
 - Expanding works and geographic areas studied (i.e. broader array of authors of, characters represented in, settings, and themes in literature read, etc.)

Infrastructure

- Environmental Studies classroom (due to be completed in 2019)
- On campus Solar array (due to be completed in 2019)
- Have committed to environmentally responsible building for all future construction projects
- Converted most public restrooms to gender neutral bathrooms

Other
