Engro Corporation Limited supports the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact on human rights, labour, environment, and anti-corruption. With this communication, we reiterate our intent to implement those principles. We remain committed to making the UN Global Compact and its principles a part of our organization's strategy, culture, and day-to-day operations, and engaging in collaborative projects that advance the broader development goals of the UN.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress (COP) that describes our company's efforts to implement the Ten Principles. This year, we have missed the date of submission for the COP and, hence, request a grace period till 30th September 2018.

We remain committed to the UN Global Compact mission and support public accountability and transparency. We pledge to submit the COP report as per UNGC guidelines, which include:

1. A statement signed by the chief executive expressing continued support for the Global Compact and renewing the company's ongoing commitment to the initiative and its principles.
2. A description of practical actions (e.g. disclosure of any relevant policies, procedures, activities) that the company has taken (and plans to take) to implement the Global Compact principles in each of the four issue areas (human rights, labour, environment, anti-corruption).
3. A measurement of outcomes (i.e., the degree to which targets/performance indicators were met, or other, qualitative or quantitative, measurements of results).
