To our stakeholders:

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the biennial preparation and posting of a Communication on Progress (COP) that comprises of a CEO statement of continued support for the UN Global Compact, a description of practical actions with regard to the principles of the UN Global Compact, and a measurement of outcomes or expected outcomes.

We are late in creating, sharing and posting our COP report due to a chronic lack of resources. However we have created some 300 local, online and international events where at each stage we directly address and help participants explore best actions in addressing the Sustainable Development Goals and the Global Compact Principles.
