## **II. Description of Actions**

DRC has been engaged in a variety of activities promoting the spirit and principles of the UN Global Compact.

Areas of engagement include:

- Engagement with Global Compact Local Networks in areas where DRC is operational and providing humanitarian support.
- Design and implementation of partnership projects around corporate sustainability
- Implementation of corporate policies fully respecting the Global Compact's Ten Principles and requiring the same from implementing partners

## **III. Measurement of Outcomes**

- In the search for solutions to displaced populations, DRC has engaged with corporates including those organized under the Global Compact in multiple countries. One key initiative has here been the launch of the cross-sector Solutions Alliance including business consultations at central (Geneva) and decentral level.
- Over the reporting period, DRC has been engaged in multiple projects informed by thinking around meeting needs on the ground through a Corporate Social Responsibility lense.
- DRC's internal management and compliance regulations have been updated, translated into multiple languages with clear reference to the principles also figuring under the Global Compact including environment, labor and here a specific focus on combating child labour and, not least, anti-corruption measures.  
These provisions have validity within DRC and are also requirements in formal engagement with business and other partners.
