I would like to confirm that Born to be Beautiful supports Ten Principles of the United Nations Global compact on human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. With this communication, we express our intent to implement those principles. We are committed to making UN Global Compact and its' principles part of our strategy, culture and day-to-day operations of our company, and to engage in collaborative projects which advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals Born to be Beautiful will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the biennial submission of Communication on Engagement (COE) that describes our company's efforts to implement the Ten Principles.

- A statement signed by the owner expressing continued support for the UN Global Compact and renewing our ongoing to the initiative and its' principles;

- A description of principal actions (for example disclosure of any relevant policies, procedures, activities) that company has taken to implement the UN Global Compact principles;
- A measurement of outcomes.

We also pledge to take part in the activities of the UN Global Compact where appropriate and feasible.

In September 2018 Born to Be Beautiful trained a group of 22 girls in Mbale, Uganda in manicure and pedicure to provide them with skills that will allow them to get work and get them out of the poverty. We also opened there our first salon and vocational beauty school where we train disadvantaged girls in beauty skills.
