 Promote women SME cluster and develop clusterbased Women Entrepreneurship in line with the objectives and strategies





## Past Contribution to enhance Women Empowerment and Skill Development in Bangladesh

### **Education**

WEAB believes that, prosperity of a nation depends on education which begins right from home. Girl, children of a family should be given priority on education so that she can educate her children later on. So, WEAB focuses on women education and child education.





### **Skill Development Trainings**

In many cases we find women cannot attain their ultimate potential due to lack of proper training. WEAB began to conduct several training programs since inception. For example- Now it has 24 SME clusters and some clusters are proven highly beneficial for the women, such as-Agro Based SME Clusters, Jute Clusters, Mushroom Clusters, Herbal Clusters, and Bamboo Clusters etc.

With the aim of empowering women WEAB provides opportunities to women by planning, trainings, organizing seminars, financial assistance and opening a marketing outlet.







### **Gender Equality**

WEAB has organized many programs related to attain gender equality. It always has tried to do something new on Women's Day. It also arranged rallies, seminars and numerous of discussions on the gender equality issue.







### **Social Awareness of Women**

WEAB always emphasized on the social awareness issue. WEAB believes that without being aware about the society a person lives in, she can't take her steps in right direction. So, it provided training and policy advocacy sessions to create awareness amongst women.







### **Humanitarian activities**

### Building home and given fishing nets to the "Sidr" (Natural Disaster) affected people:

When people of the northern part of Bangladesh became seriously wounded by the cyclone called Sidr. WEAB rushed to the disaster areas in Amtali, Barguna to help the

victim by constructing Small Houses provided boats and fishing net to rehabilitate the "Sidr" affected people.







### **Helping the Acid Burn Victims**

WEAB has helped Acid burn victims by rehabilitant them in society.





### **Stopping Early Marriage:**

WEAB is giving full support to create awareness and stop early marriage, WEAB believes that marriage age should be above 18 years.

WEAB is also working to develop Entrepreneurship amongst widows to help them stand on their own feet.

- Training program for 5 days
- Training program for 7 days
- Long term training program with regular interval (Future expectation)





WEAB want to establish Sheuti Production house which will help women entrepreneur to access them in marketing properly, eliminate the interruption of middleman and to build a networking bridge throughout the country.
