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HUMAN RIGHTS PRINCIPLES

Principle 1: Businesses should support and respect the protection of internationally proclaimed human rights.

Principle 2: Make sure that they are not complicit in human rights abuses.

Device recognize that human rights are an integral part of corporate citizenship and Device is committed to develop an organizational culture which supports internationally recognized human rights and supports equal opportunities, dignity and mutual respect. This is clearly stated in our Human Rights Statement, in line with international best practices.

Implementation

Device expresses the intention to support individual human rights and compliance with all applicable laws and regulations, which are also clearly stated in the employment contract. We make sure that employees enjoy fundamental labour rights like a safe workplace, non-discriminatory work practices and collective bargaining. We create accessible workplace or providing a workplace free from discrimination.

Device provides equal employment opportunities and complies with Employment Laws and Regulations. Device is committed to treat our employees with no illegal discrimination based on race, religion, gender, social status, physical or mental disability, and sexual orientation.

Measurement of Outcomes

We believe that as a result of these measures, there was no violation of Human Rights for all of our employees. We monitor and evaluate performance through our yearly employee survey. We conduct yearly performance appraisals with every employee on a one to one basis to ensure that everyone is heard.

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LABOUR PRINCIPLES

We uphold the rights of employees to freedom of association and recognize the collective bargaining. An open door policy has been established where employees can report grievances to their upper management and HR Manager.

We promote and support the elimination of all forms of forced and compulsory labour. We do not employ any form of forced labour because we consider that as fundamental violation of human rights.

Also, we are totally against the practice of child labour. All job applications are subjected to detailed screening by our HR personnel.

All employees in Device are given equal opportunities; hiring and promotion of employees are based on criteria like academic qualifications, skills and track record.

Implementation

Device has always been supportive of the freedom of association and the effective recognition of the right to collective bargaining. Prior to employment, it is our policy to be transparent about the working terms and conditions.
