- Engaged members in collective action efforts on UN Global Compact related issues by creating "More than a Market" brochure to show German Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) activities in the Philippines.
- Attracted new participants to the UN Global Compact through their outreach efforts and awareness raising by including the importance of the UN Global Compact and its 10 Principles.
- A roundtable discussion was conducted regarding the CSR activities of German companies and potential collaborations.
- · Waste water compliance Training with German experts for Philippine SMEs.
- The promotion of Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy and Water Management Solutions in both private and pubic stakeholders in the Philippines through trade activities and business delegations.
- Fostering Dual Training Partnerships to secure skilled labor for businesses while at the same time capacitating Filipinos with further skills for more opportunity to generate income.

- Invited 10 member companies to be part of the roundtable discussion; 4 of which participated.
- Waste Water Compliance Training with over 100 Philippine companies who joined in 2018.
- Energy Efficiency with over 90 conference guests in 2017.
- Renewable Energy with over 90 conference guests in 2018.
- (Dual) Training:
 - Train the Trainer capacitated around 30 in-company trainers.
 - Export Management Training with department of Trade and Industry capacitated 60 Filipino companies.
 - K12 Dual Training Initiative with 50 graduates in the metal working industry.
 - Quality Assurance for Automotive Maintenance Service Technician Course in close cooperation with the German Automotive company that garnered 117 graduates.
