

Our new COP report will be posted on the UN Global Compact website by April 1, 2019 at the latest including.

This includes:

- A statement signed by the chief executive officer expressing continuous support for the UN Global Compact and renewing our ongoing commitment to the initiative and its principles. This is separate from our initial letter of commitment to join the UN Global Compact.
- A description of practical actions (i.e., disclosure of any relevant policies, procedures, activities) that the company has taken (or plans to undertake) to implement the UN Global Compact principles in each of the fourtargeted areas (human rights, labor, environment, anti-corruption).
- A measurement of outcomes (i.e., the target based results/ KPIs or other qualitative or quantitative measurements of results).
