Human Rights

- All Geopolicity's employees have been provided with a safe work space, as well as suitable and sanitary facilities.
- Geopolicity's employees and collaborators have been protected from workplace harassment, including physical, verbal, sexual or psychological harassment, abuse and/or threats.
- Geopolicity has supported a number of Women in Development conferences in the MENA region.
- Geopolicity Inc. has taken measures to eliminate ingredients, designs, defects or sideeffects that could harm or threaten human life and health during manufacturing, usage or disposal of products.

Labour

- Geopolicity Inc. has not participated in any form of forced or bonded labour.
- Geopolicity Inc. is and has been compliant with minimum wage standards.
- Geopolicity worked with WEF on the Global Employment Pledge.
- Geopolicity Inc. has ensured that employment-related decisions are based on relevant and objective criteria.

Environment

- Geopolicity presented at the Global Environment Facility (GEF 7) in Vietnam.
- Geopolicity CEO Peter Middlebrook gave a Key Note Speech at the UN High Level Political Forum on the SDGs and the Environment.
- Geopolicity Inc. has avoided environmental damage via regular maintenance of production processes and environmental protection system (air pollution control, waste, water treatment systems, etc.).
- Geopolicity Inc. has ensured emergency procedures to prevent and address accidents affecting the environment and human health.
- Geopolicity Inc. has minimized the use and ensured safe handling and storage of chemical and other dangerous substances.



Anti-Corruption
