Focus towards social responsibility is very well woven in the functioning of The International School of Management Excellence. The School reaches out to various Children's Homes (Swanthana, Thayi Mane) and Old Age homes (Asha Bhawan) in the vicinity though its volunteer students and staff to bring joy and happiness in the lives of the destitute and the old by spending quality time with the inmates. In an effort to help the organizations procure their resources and to function smoothly, the school often contributes materially (Snacks, Groceries, toiletries, clothes) and financially.
