Dear AIESEC United States stakeholders,

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual preparation and posting of a Communication on Progress (COP) that comprises of a CEO statement of continued support for the UN Global Compact, a description of practical actions with regard to the principles of the UN Global Compact, and a measurement of outcomes or expected outcomes.

We are late in creating, sharing, and posting our COP report due to a couple factors. Due to outages on our global platform, we have had delays in receiving the data of our exchange participants that are relevant to the reporting presented in the COP. There have also been some shifts in our global timeline of events, causing us to push up our national timeline. This has left us with a tight schedule, and not fully capable of submitting the COP in time.

We hereby ask for an extension period in order to be able to post a COP that describes our company's efforts and progress to implement the principles of the UN Global Compact. Our new COP report will be posted on the UN Global Compact website by September 1st, 2019, at the latest.
